NOTICE OF PREPARATION OF REGULATORY IMPACT STATEMENT

Proposed Working with Children Amendment (Fees) Regulations 2012

Notice is given in accordance with section 11 of the **Subordinate Legislation Act 1994** that a Regulatory Impact Statement (RIS) has been prepared for the proposed Working with Children Amendment (Fees) Regulations 2012.

The proposed Regulations, to be made under section 49 of the **Working with Children Act** 2005, increase the fee for an employee working with children check from 6.51 fee units to 8.0 fee units and reduce the fee for an employee replacement card from 1.49 fee units to 1.0 fee unit.

The objective of the proposed Regulations is to set the fee of an employee working with children check and the fee of a replacement working with children check card at cost recovery. The prescribed fees for each service were originally set in 2006 and have been indexed annually in accordance with the annual rate set by the Treasurer pursuant to the **Monetary Units Act 2004**.

The RIS examines the costs and benefits of the proposed Regulations and possible alternatives and concludes that the proposed Regulations are the most efficient method of achieving the objective.
