Melbourne City Link Act 1995

ORDER UNDER SECTION 56ZL(2) OF THE MELBOURNE CITY LINK ACT 1995

- I, Terry Mulder, Minister for Roads and Minister administering the **Melbourne City Link Act 1995** ('the Act'), in accordance with section 56ZL(2) of the Act, make an Order that section 56ZL of the Act no longer applies to the following land:
- (a) parcel 115A on Roads Corporation Survey Plan SP22668A; and
- (b) parcels 163A and 163B on Roads Corporation Survey Plan SP22670B.

In accordance with section 56ZL(3) of the Act, I direct that the land specified above be vested in the Roads Corporation.

On the publication of this Order in the Government Gazette, by operation of section 56ZL(4) of the Act, the land specified above vests in fee simple in the Roads Corporation, and section 56ZL no longer applies to the land.



EXEMPTION FROM GIVING NOTICE OF THE PROPOSED DISCONTINUANCE OF PART OF MONASH FREEWAY FOR MONASH-CITYLINK-WEST GATE (M1) UPGRADE PROJECT PURPOSES

I, Terry Mulder, Minister for Roads, under sub-section 12(11)(b) of the **Road Management Act 2004** exempt VicRoads from the requirements of sub-sections 12(4) to 12(10) of that Act for the proposed road discontinuance of part of Monash Freeway in Hawthorn, at the location shown generally in the diagram below (cross-hatched) and more particularly as parcel 164 on Roads Corporation Survey Plan SP22670B, a copy of which may be requested from VicRoads.



NOTICE OF DECLARATION OF LINK ROAD – SOUTHERN LINK

I, Terry Mulder, Minister for Roads and Minister administering the **Melbourne City Link Act 1995** ('the Act'), in accordance with section 61(3) of the Act, give notice that I have today made a declaration under section 61(1) of the Act. A copy of that declaration is printed with this notice.

By operation of the definition of 'Link road' in section 3 of the Act, the land the subject of the declaration is part of the Link road.

On the publication of this notice in the Government Gazette, by operation of section 61(4) of the Act, the road specified in the declaration is deemed to be –

- (a) a freeway within the meaning of the Road Management Act 2004; and
- (b) a road open to and for use by the public for passage of vehicles; and
- (c) a highway within the meaning of the Road Safety Act 1986.

- (b) state that the roads described in Schedule A and on the attached plans are to be treated as a freeway.




FREEWAY LINK ROAD - SOUTHERN LINK CITY OF YARRA





CITY OF BOROONDARA





