SECTION 15 NOTICE

I, Peter Corcoran, the Director Maritime Safety (as delegate of the Director, Transport Safety), on the recommendation of Geoffrey Rollinson, Director Infrastructure Planning and Regulatory Services, Gannawarra Shire Council (Waterway Manager for Kangaroo Lake), hereby give notice under section 15(1) of the **Marine Act 1988** that:

- 1. From 6.30 am to 6.00 pm on Saturday 25 and Sunday 26 February 2012, bathing and the operation of vessels (including anchoring, mooring or allowing a vessel to lie), excluding vessels and bathers involved with the Ski Racing Victoria Point Score Race No. 5, is prohibited on all of the waters of Kangaroo Lake;
- 2. Vessels competing in the Ski Racing Victoria Point Score Race No. 5 at Kangaroo Lake are excluded from the requirements of Clauses 2(a), 2(c) and 3(b) of Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988** for the duration of the event;
- 3. Vessels competing in the Ski Racing Victoria Point Score Race No. 5 at Kangaroo Lake are exempt from the requirements of Regulation 228(3) of the Marine Regulations 2009, in respect to the requirement to carry a torch, bailer, bucket and lifebuoy for the duration of the event; and
- 4. At the completion of the event or at a time determined by Gannawarra Shire Council to enable the completion of the event, the waters will revert to the provisions of Schedule 140 contained in Notice No.1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**.

SECTION 15 NOTICE

I, Peter Corcoran, the Director Maritime Safety (as delegate of the Director, Transport Safety), on the recommendation of Vincent Wright, Acting Regional Manager, Bays and Maritime Operations, Parks Victoria (Waterway Manager for the Yarra River upstream of the Designated Port of Port Phillip), hereby give notice under section 15(1) of the **Marine Act 1988** that:

- 1. Between the hours of 9.00 am and 12.00 noon and 1.00 pm and 3.30 pm on Saturday 25 February 2012, bathing and the operation of vessels (including anchoring, mooring or allowing a vessel to lie), excluding vessels owned and operated by Parks Victoria and vessels involved in the Australian Henley Regatta rowing event, are prohibited on all the waters of the Yarra River between a diagonal line from the downstream edge of the VRA landing to the upstream edge of Federation Wharf, and the Church Street Bridge:
- 2. Vessels involved in the Australian Henley Regatta rowing event are exempt from the 5 knot speed limit as detailed in clause 1 of Schedule 3 contained in Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988** for the duration of the event;
- 3. Vessels involved in the Australian Henley Regatta rowing event are excluded from the requirement to operate a vessel at a speed not exceeding 5 knots within 50 metres of another vessel, 50 meters of the waters edge, and 50 metres of a fixed or floating structure in or on the water, as detailed clauses 2(c) and 3 of Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the Marine Act 1988 for the duration of the event; and
- 4. At the completion of the event or at a time determined by Parks Victoria to enable the completion of the event, the waters will revert to the provisions of Schedule 3 contained in Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**.

I, Peter Corcoran, the Director Maritime Safety (as delegate of the Director, Transport Safety), on the recommendation of Vincent Wright, Acting Regional Manager, Bays and Maritime Operations, Parks Victoria (Waterway Manager for the Yarra River upstream of the Designated Port of Port Phillip), hereby give notice under section 15(1) of the **Marine Act 1988** that:

1. From 2.00 pm to 7.30 pm on Friday 2 March 2012, the operation of vessels (including anchoring, mooring or allowing a vessel to lie), excluding vessels involved with the Victorian Corporate Dragon Boat Challenge, vessels owned and operated by Parks Victoria and vessels authorised by Parks Victoria, is prohibited on the waters of the Yarra River within the area detailed below in Table 1;

Table 1: Victoria Harbour - Southern Arm Exclusion Zone

The waters bounded by:

- (i) A line extending from a point 37° 49′ 4.517328″ S, 144° 56′ 32.55144″ E to a point 37° 49′ 1.674408″ S, 144° 56′ 39.984″ E;
- (ii) A line extending from a point 37° 49′ 1.674408″ S, 144° 56′ 39.984″ E to a point 37° 49′ 3.717228″ S, 144° 56′ 41.3412″ E;
- (iii) A line extending from a point 37° 49′ 3.717228″ S, 144° 56′ 41.3412″ E to a point 37° 49′ 6.613752″ S, 144° 56′ 33.76608″ E;
- (iv) A line extending from a point 37° 49′ 6.613752″ S, 144° 56′ 33.76608″ E to a point 37° 49′ 4.517328″ S, 144° 56′ 32.55144″ E.
- 2. Vessels providing rescue services for the Victorian Corporate Dragon Boat Challenge are exempt from the 5 knot speed limit as detailed in clause 1 of Schedule 3 contained in Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988** for the duration of the event;
- 3. Vessels providing rescue services for the Victorian Corporate Dragon Boat Challenge are excluded from the requirement to operate a vessel at a speed not exceeding 5 knots within 50 meters of a person in the water, another vessel, the waters edge and fixed or floating structures, as detailed clauses 2(a), 2(c) and 3 of Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988** for the duration of the event; and
- 4. At the completion of the event or at a time determined by Parks Victoria to enable the completion of the event, the waters will revert to the provisions of Schedule 3 contained in Notice No. 1 under section 15(2) of the **Marine Act 1988**.
