# ROAD SAFETY (VEHICLES) REGULATIONS 2009

Specification of Temporary Routes for Class 1 Vehicles

## 1. Purpose

The purpose of this notice is to specify certain routes on which Class 1 vehicles may travel in order to detour the temporary road closures for the Yea Autumn Festival.

# 2. Authorising provision

This notice is made under regulation 178 of the Road Safety (Vehicles) Regulations 2009.

#### 3. Commencement

This notice comes into operation at 7.00 am on 18 March 2012.

# 4. Expiration

This notice expires at 7.00 pm on 18 March 2012.

#### 5. Declaration

- I, Don Hogben, delegate of the Roads Corporation, declare that a class 1 vehicle that is –
- (a) a load carrying vehicle or combination;
- (b) a special purpose vehicle;
- (c) an agricultural vehicle;
- (d) a vehicle operating under a permit issued under regulation 180 of the Road Safety (Vehicles) Regulations 2009 in accordance with the conditions specified in that permit; or
- (e) a vehicle travelling under Government Gazette No. S 3 dated 6 January 2010 entitled 'Class 1, 2 and 3 Vehicles with Advanced Environment and Safety Technology' in accordance with the conditions specified in that Gazette Notice –
