Road Safety Act 1986

ROAD SAFETY (VEHICLES) REGULATIONS 2009

Specification of Temporary Routes for Heavy or Large Vehicles

1. Purpose

The purpose of this notice is to specify routes on which class 1, 2 and 3 vehicles exceeding mass or dimension limits may travel in order to detour the temporary road closures for the Yackandandah Folk Festival.

2. Authorising provisions

This notice is made under regulations 178, 188 and 194 of the Road Safety (Vehicles) Regulations 2009 (the 'Vehicles Regulations').

Regulation 178 provides that the Roads Corporation may, by notice published in the Government Gazette, exempt a category of class 1 vehicles from a mass or dimension limit in Schedule 7 to the Vehicles Regulations, on any conditions it thinks fit.

Regulation 188 provides that the Roads Corporation may, by notice published in the Government Gazette, exempt a category of class 2 vehicles from a mass or dimension limit in Schedule 8 to the Vehicles Regulations, on any conditions it thinks fit.

Regulation 194 provides that the Roads Corporation may, by notice published in the Government Gazette, exempt a category of class 3 vehicles from a mass or dimension limit in Schedule 9 to the Vehicles Regulations, on any conditions it thinks fit.

3. Commencement

This notice comes into operation on 23 March 2012.

4. Expiry

This notice expires on 25 March 2012.

5. Declaration

I, Don Hogben, delegate of the Roads Corporation, declare that a class 1, class 2 or class 3 vehicle travelling under a Gazette notice exempting it from a mass or dimension limit in Schedule 7, 8 or 9 to the Vehicles Regulations may, on the conditions specified in that notice, travel on the routes and at the times specified in the Table below.
