
Schedule 11 Clause 4

DESIGNATION OF TOW AWAY AREAS

Clause 4 of Schedule 11 to the **Local Government Act 1989** provides that a Council may move or impound any vehicle that is causing an unlawful obstruction, or that is unlawfully parked or left standing in an area designated by the Minister (referred to in this instrument as a 'tow-away area'), and may charge the owner of the vehicle a fee up to the amount of the fee set for the purposes of clause 3(1)(c).

For the purposes of that provision, I, Terry Mulder, Minister for Roads, designate the area depicted within the boundary line on the plan under this text, including all parts of the roads on the perimeter of that area, to be a tow-away area.

This instrument takes effect at 12.01 am on Thursday 15 March 2012 and expires at 11.59 pm on Sunday 18 March 2012.



DESIGNATION OF TOW AWAY AREAS

Clause 4 of Schedule 11 of the **Local Government Act 1989** provides that a municipal Council may move or impound any vehicle that is causing an unlawful obstruction, or that is unlawfully parked or left standing in an area designated by the Minister (referred to in this instrument as a 'tow-away area'), and may charge the owner of the vehicle a fee up to the amount of the fee set for the purposes of clause 3(1)(c).

For the purposes of that provision, I, Terry Mulder, Minister for Roads, designate the locations specified and shown on the attached plan, to be a tow-away area.



This instrument takes effect at 12.00 pm on Sunday 11 March 2012 and expires at 2.00 pm on Monday 12 March 2012.

- Swanston Street, between Flinders Street and Princes Bridge (southbound only);
- Princes Bridge (southbound only); and
- St Kilda Road, between Princes Bridge and Domain Road (southbound service road only). Dated 5 March 2012
