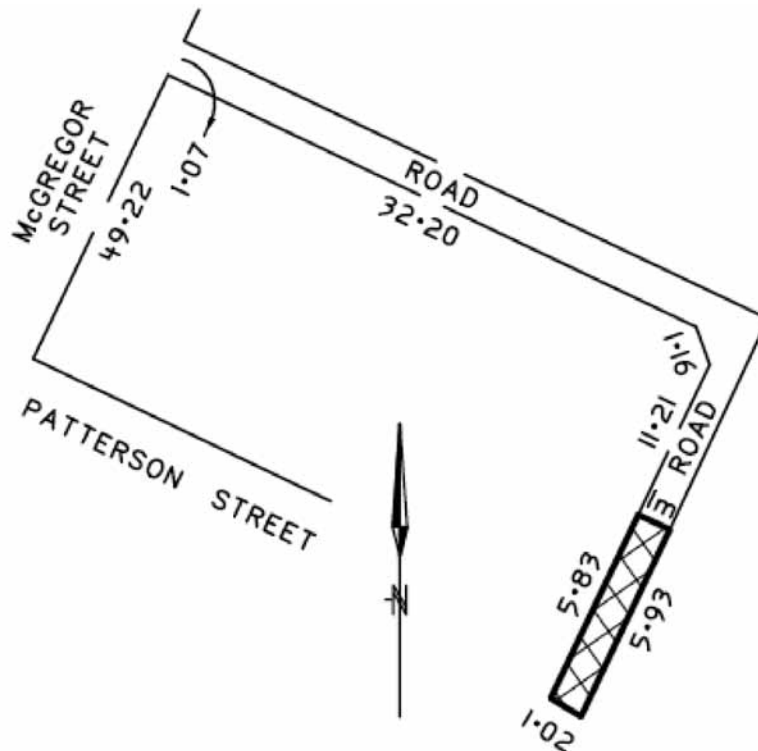

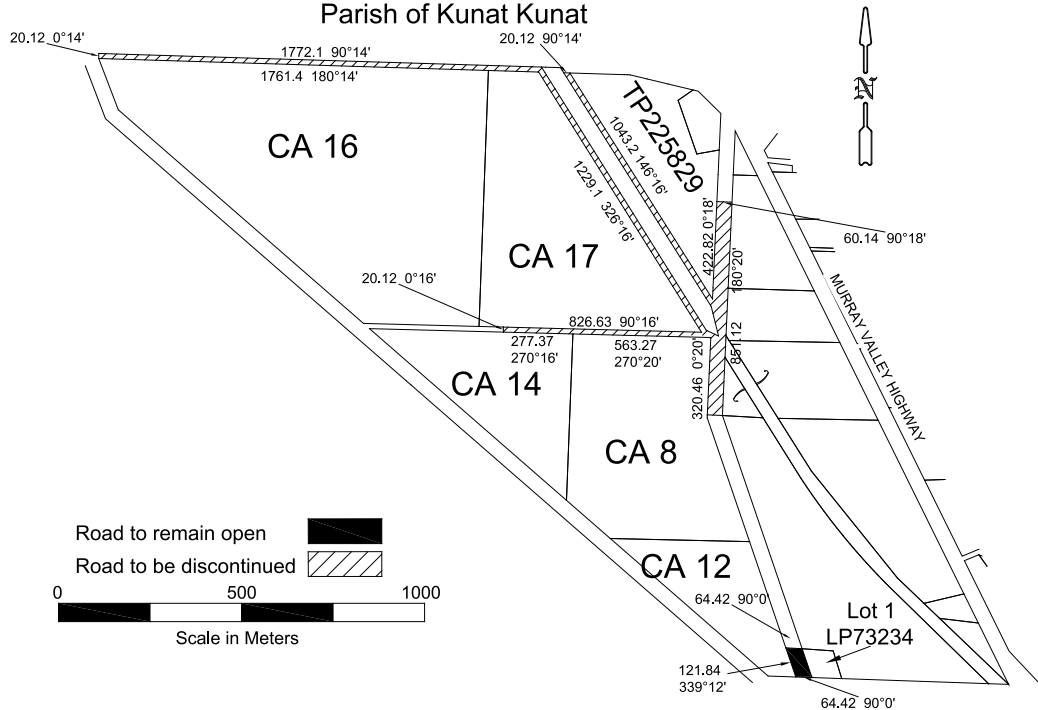

The Victorian Civil and Administrative Tribunal has considered an application pursuant to section 89 of the **Equal Opportunity Act 2010** (the Act) by Cooroonya Domestic Violence Services Inc (the applicant). The application for exemption is to enable the applicant to advertise for and employ only women in the applicant organisation (the exempt conduct).

Upon reading the material filed in support of this application, including the affidavit of Lorraine Hogan, the Tribunal is satisfied that it is appropriate to grant an exemption from sections 16, 107 and 182 of the Act to enable the applicant to engage in the exempt conduct.

In granting this exemption the Tribunal noted:

- The applicant is a non-profit, gender-specific specialist family violence agency which exists to provide a crisis response to women and children experiencing family violence. The applicant was established to empower women and children to regain control and independence in their lives and to provide innovative, accountable and confidential services for them.
- It is the applicant's experience that women experiencing domestic or family violence, including crisis needs, expect the service response to come from female workers.

Such a service response is also part of an established tradition of women's services to and by women. It is appropriate that the applicant's services be provided in an environment which is safe and one which encourages openness on the part of clients so as to ensure that their needs can be identified and met. That is best achieved by the services being provided by women.

- An exception based on the same circumstances and on the same terms was granted in March 2009 and expired on 1 March 2012 (A19/2012). No exception or current exemption already applies to the exempt conduct and in the absence of an exemption the exempt conduct would amount to prohibited discrimination.
- When making decisions about exemptions, the Tribunal is required to give proper consideration to relevant human rights as set out in the **Charter of Human Rights and Responsibilities Act 2006** (Charter). Arguably, this exemption limits the right to equality and in particular the right to equal and effective protection against discrimination of men who would wish to be employed by the applicant. I am satisfied that, in the circumstances discussed above, the limit imposed by this exemption is reasonable and justified under the Charter.

The Tribunal hereby grants an exemption from the operation of sections 16, 107 and 182 of the Act to enable the applicant to engage in the exempt conduct.

This exemption is to remain in force from the day on which notice of the exemption is published in the Government Gazette until 7 March 2017.

Upon reading the material filed in support of this application, including the affidavit of Lorraine Hogan, the Tribunal is satisfied that it is appropriate to grant an exemption from sections 44, 52, 53, 107 and 182 of the Act to enable the applicant to engage in the exempt conduct.

In granting this exemption the Tribunal noted:

- The applicant is a non-profit, gender-specific specialist family violence agency which exists to provide a crisis response to women and children experiencing family violence. The applicant was established to empower women and children to regain control and independence in their lives and to provide innovative, accountable and confidential services for them.
- The applicant responds to the immediate safety needs of women and children. It provides access to safe and secure short term accommodation and support for women and children exposed to family violence. Other services provided by the applicant include: providing appropriate facilities, programs and services for women and children who have been exposed to domestic violence, including by referring clients to other organisations; providing intensive interventions for its clients including regular group sessions, individual counselling and personal development designed to best suit the client's needs; and providing support and services to allow women and children to re-establish themselves in the community. These services are provided in a culturally appropriate and sensitive manner by trained workers.
- A fundamental feature of family violence is that it is gender based, with the perpetrators usually being males. The impact of domestic or family violence on women and children is profound. It has immediate and long-term consequences for the economic, psychological, physical, emotional and social well being of women and children. It is appropriate that the applicant's services be provided in an environment which is safe and one which encourages openness on the part of clients so as to ensure that their needs can be identified and met. In all the circumstances, it is appropriate that the applicant's services be available to women only and their children.

- An exception based on the same circumstances and on the same terms was granted in March 2009 and expired on 1 March 2012 (A20/2012). No exception or current exemption already applies to the exempt conduct and in the absence of an exemption the exempt conduct would amount to prohibited discrimination.
- When making decisions about exemptions, the Tribunal is required to give proper consideration to relevant human rights as set out in the **Charter of Human Rights and Responsibilities Act 2006** (Charter). Arguably, this exemption limits the right to equality and in particular the right to equal and effective protection against discrimination of males aged 18 and over who would wish to access the applicant's services. I am satisfied that, in the circumstances discussed above, the limit imposed by this exemption is reasonable and justified under the Charter.

The Tribunal hereby grants an exemption from the operation of sections 44, 52, 53, 107 and 182 of the Act to enable the applicant to engage in the exempt conduct.
