Road Safety Act 1986

DECLARATION UNDER SECTION 99B(4) IN RELATION TO NON-ROAD ACTIVITIES ON PART OF THE GREAT ALPINE ROAD FOR THE BRIGHT AUTUMN FESTIVAL GALA DAY PARADE SATURDAY 5 MAY 2012

1 Purpose

The purpose of this declaration is to exempt participants in the Bright Autumn Festival Gala Day Parade from specified provisions of the Road Safety Road Rules 2009 with respect to a non-road activity, namely the Bright Autumn Festival Gala Day Parade, parts of which are to take place on the Great Alpine Road, Bright on Saturday 5 May 2012.

2 Authorising provision

This notice is made under section 99B(4) of the **Road Safety Act 1986**. Section 99B(4) provides that the Minister may, by notice published in the Government Gazette, declare that specified provisions of the **Road Safety Act 1986** and of the regulations made under that Act do not apply with respect to a non-road activity specified in the notice during the period specified in this notice.

3 Commencement

This declaration takes effect on Saturday 5 May 2012.

4 Definitions

In this notice –

- (a) ‘the event’ means the Bright Autumn Festival Gala Day Parade, to be held on 5 May 2012; and
- (b) ‘participants’ means bona fide participants in the event, including officers, members and authorised agents of the Alpine Shire Council, whose presence is reasonably required to ensure safe conduct of the event.

5 Declaration

I, Steve Brown, delegate of the Minister for Roads, declare under section 99B(4) of the **Road Safety Act 1986** that the provisions of the Road Safety Road Rules 2009 specified in the Table do not apply to the event to be conducted on the Great Alpine Road (Gavan Street) between Anderson Street and Delaney Avenue, Bright on Saturday 5 May 2012 from 1.15 pm to 3.30 pm.

6 Condition

A copy of this notice must be produced on demand to any member of the police force or to any person who is an authorised officer under section 71 of the **Road Management Act 2004**. However, failure to comply with this condition does not invalidate the exemption given by this notice.

1. Purpose

This notice is made under regulation 178 of the Road Safety (Vehicles) Regulations 2009.

3. Commencement

This notice comes into operation on the date it is published in the Government Gazette.

4. Expiry

This notice expires on Saturday 5 May 2012.

5. Declaration

I, Don Hogben, delegate of the Roads Corporation, declare that a class 1 vehicle that is –

- (a) a load carrying vehicle or combination;
- (b) a special purpose vehicle;
- (c) an agricultural vehicle; or
- (d) a vehicle operating under a permit issued under regulation 180 of the Road Safety (Vehicles) Regulations 2009 in accordance with the conditions specified in that permit –

may travel on the routes during the permitted period specified in the Table below –
