## PROPOSED MINISTERIAL ORDER – TEACHER REGISTRATION FEES 2012–13

### Release of Regulatory Impact Statement

#### Notice

The Victorian Institute of Teaching (VIT) is a statutory authority responsible for the regulation of the teaching profession in Victoria.

The VIT registers teachers working in Victorian government, Catholic and independent schools.

VIT funds its activities through fees charged for registration, annual fees, criminal record check fees, and a number of other activities funded on a fee-for-service basis. Fees are needed to be set in order to provide sufficient revenue for the VIT to fulfil its statutory functions effectively.

The objective of the proposed fee schedule is to set fees that reflect the costs to the VIT of performing its statutory functions, while being consistent with other policy objectives.

In accordance with the ‘Victorian Guide to Regulation’, the Victorian Government seeks to ensure that regulations and other legislative instruments are well targeted, effective and appropriate, and that they impose the lowest possible burden on the community. The VIT has prepared a Regulatory Impact Statement for the proposed fees, which found that the proposed fees are appropriate as assessed against criteria of efficiency, equity and other policy objectives.

The RIS process allows members of the community to comment on proposed legislative instruments before they are finalised. Submissions are now invited on the proposed instrument. Unless requested by the author, all submissions will be treated as public documents and may be made available to other parties.
