DECLARATION OF LAND AND PREMISES TO BE PART OF PARLIAMENTARY PRECINCTS UNDER SECTION 6(1)

Order in Council

Pursuant to section 6(1) of the **Parliamentary Precincts Act 2001**, the Governor in Council, on the recommendation of the Speaker of the Legislative Assembly and the President of the Legislative Council, declares that the following land and premises is part of the Parliamentary precincts for the period 5 September 2012 to 7 September 2012:

- the land and premises thereon known as the University of Ballarat, situated on University Drive, Mt Helen, and described as Council Property Number 2047055 being the area bounded by Gear Avenue, East Terrace, North Terrace and University Drive, and including car park number 5; and
- the land and the premises thereon known as the Bendigo Town Hall, situated at 189–193 Hargreaves Street, Bendigo and described in Crown Allotment 4B Section 10C Parish of Sandhurst at Bendigo, the Library Gardens described in Crown Allotment 4E Section 10C Parish of Sandhurst at Bendigo and the Civic Gardens described in Crown Allotment 4F Section 10C Parish of Sandhurst at Bendigo.

This Order is revoked on 8 September 2012.
