GOVERNANCE LOCAL LAW

Notice is hereby given that Bayside City Council, at its meeting held on 29 October 2013, made a Local Law entitled – Governance Local Law No. 1 (2013), which revokes the existing Local Law No. 1 – 2009 Governance Local Law in its entirety and replaces it with a new Local Law No. 1 titled ‘Governance Local Law No. 1 (2013)’.

The purpose of this Local Law is to:

- a) to provide a mechanism to facilitate the good government of the Municipal District of the City of Bayside through its formal meeting procedure to ensure effective and efficient Council decisions are made in a manner which acknowledges the role of local government within the Australian system of government;
- b) to promote and encourage community participation in local government by providing mechanisms for the Council to ascertain the community’s views and expectations;
- c) to regulate and control the election of Mayor and the Chairman of any Committees;
- d) to regulate and control the procedures governing the conduct of meetings including:
 1. the notice required for meetings;
 2. the keeping of minutes.
- e) to regulate and control the use of Council’s Seal;
- f) to provide for the administration of the Council’s powers and functions;
- g) to provide generally for the peace, order and good government of the Municipal District;
- h) to revoke Council’s Local Law No. 1 – 2009 Governance Local Law made in November 2009.

The general purport of the Local Law is to:

- establish a law which will govern order of business, rules of debate, meeting procedure, public access and conduct of meetings;

- regulate the use and control of Council’s common seal, and create an offence for a person using the common seal without authority or using a replica of the common seal without authority;
- regulate the procedure for the election of the Mayor;
- regulate the procedure of ‘Public Question Time at Ordinary Meetings of Council’;
- regulate the time limit of people making a submission to Council;
- regulate the number of signatories to a petition;
- regulate the availability of agenda papers to members of the public prior to meetings;
- regulate the procedure for acknowledging and recognising the first Councillor to move a motion;
- regulate the procedure for amending a Notice of Motion;
- regulate the procedure for petitioners speaking to petitions;
- regulate the hearing of submissions at Committee Meetings of Council only;
- regulate the procedure to ensure that no discussion prior to a motion being moved;
- regulate the procedure for Points of Order;
- create an offence for a person who interrupts a meeting or behaves in an unruly manner and who fails to come to order when called to do so; and
- revoke the existing Local Law No. 1 – 2009 Governance Local Law made in November 2009 in its entirety.

Local Government Act 1989 – Section 119(2)

Notice is hereby given that the Moira Shire Council, at its ordinary meeting held on 18 November 2013, resolved to adopt and make the Community Safety and Environment Local Law 2013 (No. 1 of 2013).

The Moira Shire Council Local Law No. 1 of 2013 (Community Safety and Environment) comes into effect on 1 December 2013, operates throughout the whole municipal district and ceases to operate on 30 November 2023, unless revoked earlier.

The objectives of the Community Safety and Environment Local Law 2013 are to:

- provide for the peace, order and good government of the municipal district of Moira Shire Council;
- provide for those matters which require a local law under the **Local Government Act 1989**, and any other Act;
- provide for the administration of Council powers and functions, and for the issue of permits and infringement notices;
- prohibit, regulate and control activities, physical works, events, practices or behaviour in the municipal district so that no detriment is caused to the amenity of the neighbourhood, nor nuisance to a person, nor detrimental effect to the environment or property;
- regulate and control the consumption of alcohol and possession of alcohol other than in a sealed container;
- protect assets vested in Council;
- regulate the droving and movement of livestock throughout the municipal district, minimise the damage to road surfaces, formations, drainage, native vegetation and surrounding areas arising from livestock and to alert other road users to the presence of livestock on roads in the interests of road safety; and

- enhance public safety and community amenity.

Notice of Preparation of Amendment

Authorisation A02617

The Ballarat City Council has prepared Amendment C164 to the Ballarat Planning Scheme.

In accordance with section 8A(3) of the **Planning and Environment Act 1987**, the Minister for Planning authorised the Ballarat City Council as planning authority to prepare the Amendment.

The land affected by the Amendment is 200, 200A and 200B Victoria Street, Ballarat East.

The Amendment proposes to:

- rezone 200 Victoria Street, Ballarat East, from Special Use Zone 5 (SUZ5) to part General Residential Zone (GRZ), part Commercial 1 Zone (CZ1) and part Mixed Use Zone (MUZ);
- rezone 200A and 200B Victoria Street, Ballarat East, from Residential 1 Zone to General Residential Zone;
- apply Heritage Overlay HO196 to parts of 200 Victoria Street;
- apply a Development Plan Overlay (DPO9) to the whole of the site (200, 200A and 200B Victoria Street);
- apply an Environmental Audit Overlay (EAO) to the whole of the site (200, 200A and 200B Victoria Street);
- amend Clauses 21.03 and 21.04 to update the maps to include this site;
- amend Heritage Overlay Schedule 177 (HO177) as it applies to the site (200 Victoria Street);
- amend Clause 21.10 Reference Documents to include the 'City of Ballarat Heritage Citation: Former Ballarat Orphanage 2012';
- amend the Incorporated Document 'Ballarat Heritage Precincts – Statements of Significance, 2006' in the form of 'Ballarat Heritage Precincts – Statements of Significance, 2006 (revised November 2013)', to remove the rear part of the site as indicated in the new HO177 and to delete any written reference to the rear part of 200 Victoria Street and Damascus College; and
