Road Safety Act 1986

DECLARATION UNDER SECTION 99B(4) AND (5) THAT CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF THE **ROAD SAFETY ACT 1986** DO NOT APPLY WITH RESPECT TO THE FILMING OF THE TAC 'THE PERFECT RIDE' COMMERCIAL

1. Purpose

The purpose of this notice is to exempt participants in the filming of the TAC 'The Perfect Ride' commercial from specified provisions of the **Road Safety Act 1986**.

2. Authorising provision

This notice is made under section 99B(4) of the **Road Safety Act 1986**. Section 99B(4) provides that the Minister may, on the application of a person proposing to conduct a non-road activity on a highway, by notice published in the Government Gazette, declare that specified provisions of the **Road Safety Act 1986** and of the regulations made under that Act do not apply with respect to the non-road activity specified in the notice during the period specified in the notice.

Section 99B(5) provides that a section 99B(4) notice may declare that the highway or part of the highway specified in the notice is not a highway under the Act for all purposes or specified purposes during the specified period.

3. Commencement

This notice takes effect on 25 March 2013 at 6.30 am. Between two Victoria Police Vehicles within a Victoria Police Rolling Road Closure.

4. Expiry

This notice expires on 27 March 2013 at 7.30 pm

5. Definitions

In this notice, unless the context or subject-matter otherwise requires -

- (a) 'Event' means the TAC 'The Perfect Ride' a commercial film to be produced by Gaffney Film Services Pty Ltd on behalf of the Feds; and
- (b) 'Participants' means participants in the Event, including officers, members and authorised agents of the Event organiser, whose presence is reasonably required to ensure the safe conduct of the Event.

6. Declaration

I, Bruce Gidley, as delegate of the Minister for Roads declare that -

under section 99B(5) of the **Road Safety Act 1986**, any highway specified in column 1 of Table 1 is not a highway for the purposes of any vehicle registration requirements under the **Road Safety Act 1986** and regulations, on the dates and during the period specified in column 3 of Table 2,

provided that the event is conducted in full compliance with any permit issued by the Roads Corporation, the Glenelg Shire, or any other authority.
