NOTICE OF PREPARATION OF REGULATORY IMPACT STATEMENT (RIS)

Water (Lake Eildon Recreational Area) (Houseboats) Regulations 2013

Notice is given in accordance with section 11 of the **Subordinate Legislation Act 1994** that a Regulatory Impact Statement (RIS) has been prepared in relation to the proposed Water (Lake Eildon Recreational Area) (Houseboats) Regulations 2013. It is intended that these will replace the current regulations which will sunset after 10 years' operation on 27 May 2013.

The proposed Regulations would provide for -

- the control and management of houseboats in the Lake Eildon Recreational Area; and
- the prescribing of fees for the administration of licences in respect of houseboats.

The key new requirement of the proposed Regulations would be that on and from 1 July 2020, all houseboats will be required to have on-board greywater treatment systems. The RIS discusses possible alternatives to the proposed Regulations such as restrictions on houseboating activity, or no regulation of that activity at all. The proposed Regulations provide the best means of balancing Government objectives of facilitating houseboating on Lake Eildon and encouraging the economic benefits that it brings to the area whilst preserving water quality in the lake. With regard to greywater treatment systems, the RIS has concluded that there is a net economic cost to the community. However, Government has taken broader considerations into account including water quality and health concerns and intends to implement this requirement for greywater treatment systems for the reasons outlined in the RIS.
