NOTICE UNDER SECTION 320(7)

Pursuant to section 320(7) of the **Transport (Compliance and Miscellaneous) Act 1983**, I fix 1 July 2013 as the relevant date for the purposes of an allocation statement, dated on or around the same date as this notice, made under section 320 of the **Transport (Compliance and Miscellaneous) Act 1983** to transfer all taxi and hire car industry related property, rights and liabilities, including relevant agreement rights and liabilities of the Secretary to the Department of Transport, Planning and Local Infrastructure to the Taxi Services Commission.

In this notice, the term 'allocation statement' has the meaning given to it in section 320(4) and (8) of the **Transport (Compliance and Miscellaneous) Act 1983**.
