MAJOR SPORTING EVENT ORDER FOR AUSTRALIAN FOOTBALL LEAGUE MATCHES FROM 2014 TO 2018 AND ASIAN FOOTBALL CONFEDERATION CHAMPIONS LEAGUE QUALIFYING MATCH TO BE PLAYED AT KARDINIA PARK STADIUM

Order in Council

The Governor in Council, under section 7 of the **Major Sporting Events Act 2009** (the Act), specifies each of the matters in Column 2 of Tables 1 and 2 in accordance with the corresponding section of the Act in Column 1 of Tables 1 and 2.

8(1)(a)	Major sporting event:	All AFL matches played at Kardinia Park Stadium from 2014 to 2018 (inclusive), including AFL practice matches, matches played in the AFL pre-season competition and the AFL Premiership season, including the AFL Finals Series.
8(1)(b)	Event venue:	Kardinia Park Stadium as depicted by the area outlined yellow on the plan LEGL./14-004 lodged in the Central Plan Office
8(2)(e)	Crowd management period:	From two hours before the advertised commencement time of each match until two hours after the conclusion of the match
8(2)(i)	Parts of the Act that apply to the major sporting event specified in this table:	Part 4 (Crowd Management)
