### **Road Safety Act 1986**

DECLARATION UNDER SECTION 99B(4) IN RELATION TO NON-ROAD ACTIVITIES ON THE ROADS SPECIFIED IN COLUMN 1 OF TABLE 2 FOR THE 2014 ASIA PACIFIC IRONMAN CHAMPIONSHIP ON SUNDAY 23 MARCH 2014

### 1 Purpose

The purpose of this Declaration is to exempt participants in the 2014 Asia Pacific Ironman Championship from specified provisions of the **Road Safety Act 1986** and regulations under that Act with respect to the Event, which is a non-road activity to be conducted on the highway(s) listed in Table 2 on Sunday 23 March 2014.

### 2 Authorising provision

This notice is made under section 99B(4) of the **Road Safety Act 1986**. Section 99B(4) provides that the Minister may, on the application of a person proposing to conduct a non-road activity on a highway, by notice published in the Government Gazette, declare that specified provisions of the **Road Safety Act 1986** and of the regulations made under that Act do not apply with respect to the non-road activity specified in the notice during the period specified in the notice.

### 3 Commencement

This notice takes effect on 3.00 am Sunday 23 March 2014.

### 4 Expiry

This notice expires at 1.00 am on Monday 24 March 2014.

### 5 Definitions

In this notice, unless the context or subject-matter otherwise requires -

- a) 'Event' means the 2014 Asia Pacific Ironman Championship, to be held on 23 March 2014; and
- b) 'Participants' means participants in the Event, including officers, members and authorised agents of the IRONMAN Asia Pacific, whose presence is reasonably required to ensure the safe conduct of the Event.

### 6 Declaration

I, Peter Todd, as delegate of the Minister for Roads, under section 99B(4) of the **Road Safety Act 1986** declare that the provisions of the **Road Safety Act 1986** and regulations specified in Table 1 do not apply to Participants engaged in activities forming part of the Event on the highway specified in column 1 of Table 2 on the date and during the period specified in column 2 of Table 2, provided there is full compliance with any conditions imposed by VicRoads and the municipal council.
