I, Peter Corcoran, the Director Maritime Safety (as delegate of the Director, Transport Safety), under section 186(2) of the **Marine Safety Act 2010** make the following Urgent Safety Rule.

A 5 knot speed limit applies to all vessels operating on the waters of Kangaroo Lake within an area (46 metres x 46 metres) marked by buoys and located in an area with its centre point 35° 36′ 8.0″ S, 143° 46′ 40.8″ E.

The buoys mark the boundary of the recently installed fish habitat structures.

This rule has effect from the time of the publication of this Notice, until 20 December 2014.

ADVICE IN RELATION TO A NOTICE OF INTENTION TO REQUEST A WATERWAY RULE

I, Peter Corcoran, Director Maritime Safety (as delegate of the Director, Transport Safety), hereby advise under section 193(3)(b)(ii) of the **Marine Safety Act 2010** that the proposed waterway rule for a vessels prohibited zone adjacent to Swan Island, Port Phillip Bay, as submitted by Parks Victoria, is of a non-material nature and that Parks Victoria is not required to comply with section 194(3)(v) of the **Marine Safety Act 2010** (public consultation) before making a request for the making of the rule under section 194 of the **Marine Safety Act 2010**.
