







Frankston City Council ('Council') proposes to make Tree Protection Local Law 2015 No. 22 to replace the existing Tree Protection Local Law 2010 No. 17. The following information about the proposed Local Law is given in accordance with section 119(2) of the Local Government Act 1989 ('the Act').

#### Purpose of the proposed Local Law

The purpose of the Local Law is to:

 protect trees growing in the Municipal District;

- require a minimum standard of tree pruning within the Municipal District for the protection of trees and public safety;
- provide for the peace, order and good government of the Municipal District; and
- protect and enhance the amenity, landscape values, environment and biodiversity of the municipality.

#### General purport of the proposed Local Law

- make it an offence in defined circumstances to lop, prune, cut, trim or direct, authorise or allow to be lopped, pruned, cut or trimmed a tree, unless a permit has been obtained;
- stipulate procedures for applying for permits and issue of permits;
- allow impoundment of any item being used to undertake works in contravention of the Local Law and introduce release and disposal provisions for an impounded item;
- prescribe penalties for offences under the Local Law.



#### **Plant Biosecurity Act 2010**

### ORDER DECLARING RESTRICTED AREAS IN VICTORIA FOR THE CONTROL OF GREEN SNAIL

I, Jaala Pulford, Minister for Agriculture, under section 32 of the **Plant Biosecurity Act 2010**, make the following Order.

#### 1. Objective

The objective of this Order is –

- (a) to declare restricted areas for the control of green snail (*Cantareus apertus* (Born)) in Victoria; and
- (b) to specify the prohibitions, restrictions and requirements which are to operate in relation to the restricted areas.

#### 2. Authorising provision

This Order is made under section 32 of the Plant Biosecurity Act 2010.

#### 3. Commencement

This Order comes into operation on the day that it is published in the Victoria Government Gazette.

#### 4. Revocation

The Order made under section 32 of the **Plant Biosecurity Act 2010**, and published in Victoria Government Gazette G41 on 9 October 2014 at page 2346, is revoked.

#### 5. Definitions

In this Order -

'Act' means the Plant Biosecurity Act 2010;

**'green snail host material'** means green snail host plant, agricultural equipment, used package or earth material;

**'green snail host plant'** means any plant, including any leafy vegetable, cutting, potted plant, turf, bare-rooted plant, mature tree, cut flower, foliage, or hay, but excluding fruit and plants in tissue culture:

**'inspector'** means a person authorised as an inspector under the Act.

#### 6. Declaration of restricted areas for the control of green snail

Each parcel of land described in Schedule 1 and Schedule 2 is declared to be a restricted area for the control of green snail.

#### 7. Affected plants and materials

This Order affects green snail host plants and green snail host materials.

#### 8. Prohibitions, restrictions and requirements

- (1) The removal of any green snail host material from a restricted area declared in clause 6, and described in schedule 1, is prohibited.
- (2) Subclause (1) does not apply to a person who removes any green snail host material from the restricted area under and in accordance with a permit issued by an inspector and complies with any conditions set out in the permit.
- (3) The removal of any green snail host plant from a restricted area declared in clause 6, and described in Schedule 2, is prohibited.
- (4) Subclause (3) does not apply to a person who removes any green snail host plant from the restricted area under and in accordance with a permit issued by an inspector and complies with any conditions set out in the permit.

#### 9. Inspector may issue directions

An inspector is authorised to issue a direction to any owner or occupier of any parcel of land described in Schedule 1-

- (a) requiring the owner or occupier to
  - (i) destroy any green snail host plant where this is considered necessary to control or prevent the spread of green snail; or
  - (ii) apply to any green snail host material any treatment for the purpose of controlling green snail, including chemicals registered, approved or permitted for the purpose of controlling green snail; or
  - (iii) clean used equipment; or
- (b) prohibiting the planting or propagation of any green snail host plant.

#### 10. Expiry

This Order remains in force for a period of 12 months after the date that it is published in the Victoria Government Gazette.

Section 35(4) of the Act provides that a person is guilty of an offence and liable for a penalty not exceeding 60 penalty units for contravening any direction of an inspector. Section 35(2) provides that an order under section 32 may authorise an inspector to issue directions to any person to do any of the things listed in section 35(1).

DECLARATION UNDER SECTION 99B(4) IN RELATION TO THE MANSFIELD TORCHLIGHT PARADE, MANSFIELD, ON 30 OCTOBER 2015 AND THE MANSFIELD GRAND PARADE, MANSFIELD, ON 31 OCTOBER 2015

#### 1 Purpose

The purpose of this Declaration is to exempt participants in the Mansfield Torchlight Parade and the Mansfield Grand Parade from specified provisions of the Road Safety Road Rules 2009 with respect to the Event, which is a non-road activity to be conducted on Highett Street, Maroondah Highway (High Street), Mount Buller Road (High Street) and Mansfield—Whitfield Road, Mansfield, on 30 October 2015 and 31 October 2015.

#### 2 Authorising provision

This notice is made under section 99B(4) of the **Road Safety Act 1986**. Section 99B(4) provides that the Minister may, on the application of a person proposing to conduct a non-road activity on a highway, by notice published in the Government Gazette, declare that specified provisions of the **Road Safety Act 1986** and of the regulations made under that Act do not apply with respect to the non-road activity specified in the notice during the period specified in the notice.
