Road Management Act 2004

DESIGNATION OF TOW AWAY AREA UNDER SCHEDULE 4 CLAUSE 5 FOR ASIA-PACIFIC IRONMAN CHAMPIONSHIP MELBOURNE

Clause 5 of Schedule 4 to the **Road Management Act 2004** provides that a State road authority may move, keep or impound any vehicle that is unlawfully parked or left standing in an area designated by the Minister (referred to in this instrument as a 'tow-away area'), and may charge the owner of the vehicle a reasonable fee.


For the purposes of that provision, I, John Merritt, Chief Executive of the Roads Corporation and delegate of the Minister for Roads, designate the locations specified and shown on the attached plan to be a tow-away area to facilitate the Asia-Pacific Ironman Championship Melbourne.

This instrument takes effect at 3.00 am on Sunday 22 March 2015 and expires at 11.00 pm on Sunday 22 March 2015.

Road Safety Act 1986

DECLARATION UNDER SECTION 99B(4) IN RELATION TO NON-ROAD ACTIVITIES ON THE ROADS SPECIFIED IN COLUMN 1 OF TABLE 2 FOR THE IRONMAN ASIA-PACIFIC CHAMPIONSHIP MELBOURNE ON 22 AND 23 MARCH 2015

1 Purpose

The purpose of this Declaration is to exempt participants in the Ironman Asia-Pacific Championship Melbourne 2015 from specified provisions of the **Road Safety Act 1986** and regulations under that Act with respect to the Event, which is a non-road activity to be conducted on the highway(s) listed in Table 2 on 22 and 23 March 2015.

2 Authorising provision

This notice is made under section 99B(4) of the **Road Safety Act 1986**. Section 99B(4) provides that the Minister may, on the application of a person proposing to conduct a non-road activity on a highway, by notice published in the Government Gazette, declare that specified provisions of the **Road Safety Act 1986** and of the regulations made under that Act do not apply with respect to the non-road activity specified in the notice during the period specified in the notice.

3 Commencement

This notice takes effect on 3.00 am Sunday 22 March 2015.

4 Expiry

This notice expires at 1.10 am on Monday 23 March 2015.

5 Definitions

In this notice, unless the context or subject matter otherwise requires -

- a) 'Event' means the Ironman Asia-Pacific Championship Melbourne, to be held on 22 and 23 March 2015; and
- b) 'Participants' means participants in the Event, including officers, members and authorised agents of IRONMAN Asia Pacific, whose presence is reasonably required to ensure the safe conduct of the Event.

6 Declaration

I, John Merritt, as delegate of the Minister for Roads, under section 99B(4) of the **Road Safety Act 1986**, declare that the provisions of the **Road Safety Act 1986** and regulations specified in Table 1 do not apply to Participants engaged in activities forming part of the Event on the highway specified in column 1 of Table 2 on the date and during the period specified in column 2 of Table 2, provided there is full compliance with any conditions imposed by VicRoads and the municipal council.
