## Marine Safety Act 2010 Section 211(1)(b)

### NOTICE CONTROLLING NAVIGATION IN THE VICINITY OF WORKS

I, Peter William Corcoran, Director Maritime Safety (as delegate of the Director, Transport Safety), make the following notice under section 211(1)(b)(i) of the **Marine Safety Act 2010**.

For the purposes of the works activity proposed by Haejoo Pty Ltd for the installation of 25 fish reefs at Torquay, persons and the navigation and other movement of vessels in the works area is prohibited, excluding persons and vessels involved in the works.

The works area is the waters approximately 1 nautical mile off the coast of Torquay in an area 600 metres by 250 metres, with GPS coordinates detailed in Table 1.
