- Single is the basic network tariff for general residential or small business consumption. The tariff has daily supply charge and energy consumption charge that apply 24 hours per day, 7 days per week. There is no Off Peak and Shoulder charge associated with this tariff.
- ² Units 'c/kWh' = cents per kilowatt and is the unit measurement for electricity bill. 'c/day' = cents/day.
- Daily Supply Charge is charge that applies for supplying electricity to your premises for each day of the billing period, regardless of how much electricity you consume.
- Controlled Load (hot water and heating) is the basic network tariff for general consumption, and electric hot water and/or storage space heaters (only for controlled load generally between 10 pm and 7 am AEST) using a time-switch. Only available to installations currently taking supply under these rates.
- 5-Day Time of Use is the basic network tariff for residential and small business consumption where consumption charges vary based on Peak and Off Peak times. Peak rates generally apply between 7 am and 11 pm Monday to Friday AEST, and Off Peak rates generally apply between 11 pm and 7 am Monday to Friday AEST, and all weekend.

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- ⁶ 7-Day Time of Use is the basic network tariff for small business consumption where consumption charges vary based on Peak and Off Peak times. Peak rates generally apply between 7 am and 11 pm Monday to Sunday AEST, and Off Peak rates generally apply between 11 pm and 7 am Monday to Sunday AEST.
- Peak Summer Consumption is the summer peak rates that apply for period 1 November to 31 March.
- Peak Non Summer Consumption is the non summer peak rates that apply for period 1 April to 31 October.

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
