Notice of Approval of Amendment Amendment GC50

The Minister for Planning has approved Amendment GC50 to the Melbourne Planning Scheme and Port Phillip Planning Scheme.

The Amendment comes into operation on the date this notice is published in the Government Gazette.

The Amendment inserts a new local policy which specifies a number of targets for dwelling diversity, affordable housing and employment within the Fishermans Bend Urban Renewal Area; inserts a new schedule to the Design and Development Overlay with mandatory heights and setbacks and updates the incorporated document, Fishermans Bend Strategic Framework Plan July 2014 (amended September 2015).
