



Amendment C160

The Moreland City Council has prepared Amendment C160 to the Moreland Planning Scheme.

The land affected by the Amendment is located at 1–9 Moreland Road, Coburg.

The Amendment proposes to:

- rezone the site to part Commercial 2 Zone (C2Z) and part Mixed Use Zone (MUZ);



Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals (Control of Use) Act 1992 ORDER PROHIBITING THE FEEDING OF STOCK FOOD CONTAINING RESTRICTED ANIMAL MATERIAL TO RUMINANTS

Order in Council

The Governor in Council makes the following Order:

1 Objective

The objective of this Order is to prohibit the feeding of stock food containing restricted animal material to ruminants.

2 Authorising provision

This Order is made under section 25A(2) of the Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals (Control of Use) Act 1992.

3 Commencement

This Order takes effect on the day of its publication in the Government Gazette.

4 Revocation

The Order prohibiting the feeding of stock food containing restricted animal material made by Governor in Council on 13 December 2005 and published in Government Gazette No. G50 on 15 December 2005 at pages 2951 and 2952, is **revoked**.

5 Definitions

In this Order -

Act means the Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals (Control of Use) Act 1992;

'bag' includes any container or package;

'compounded feed' means manufactured feed that contains restricted animal material, whether or not it has undergone a manufacturing process which precludes visual identification of the ingredients;

'meal' means blood meal, meat meal, meat and bone meal and any other meal made from animal origin;

'restricted animal material' has the same meaning as in the Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals (Control of Use) (Ruminant Feed) Regulations 2015;

'ruminant' means any animal that chews its cud.

6 Restrictions on feeding stock food containing restricted animal material to ruminants

- (1) A person must not feed, offer as food, or fail to reasonably prevent exposure to restricted animal material, compounded feed or meal containing restricted animal material to a ruminant, except for the purposes of research and in accordance with a permit issued under Schedule 1 to the Act for the purposes of section 25A(2)(b) of the Act.
- (2) A person must not feed, offer as food, or fail to reasonably prevent exposure to bulk compounded feed, or bulk meal to a ruminant if the invoice or other document relating to the purpose of the feed or meal contains the following statement –

'This product contains restricted animal material – DO NOT FEED TO CATTLE, SHEEP, GOATS, DEER OR OTHER RUMINANTS'.

(3) A person must not feed, offer as food, or fail to reasonably prevent exposure to bagged compounded feed, or bagged meal, to a ruminant if the bag, a label on the bag, or a tag firmly attached to the bag contains the following statement – 'This product contains restricted animal material – DO NOT FEED TO CATTLE, SHEEP, GOATS, DEER OR OTHER RUMINANTS'.
