Notice of Approval of Amendment

Amendment VC138

The Minister for Planning has approved Amendment VC138 to the Victoria Planning Provisions (VPP) and all planning schemes in Victoria.

The Amendment comes into operation on the date this notice is published in the Government Gazette.

The Amendment implements reforms relating to the Victorian Government's review of the planning provisions for native vegetation removal following the release of 'Protecting Victoria's Environment – Biodiversity 2037'.

The Amendment changes the VPP and all planning schemes in Victoria by:

- Amending Clause 12 (Biodiversity)
- Amending Clause 42.01 (Environmental Significance Overlay)
- Amending Clause 42.02 (Vegetation Protection Overlay)
- Amending Clause 42.03 (Significant Landscape Overlay)
- Amending Clause 44.01 (Erosion Management Overlay)
- Amending Clause 44.02 (Salinity Management Overlay)
- Amending Clause 52.16 (Native Vegetation Precinct Plans)
- Amending Clause 52.17 (Native Vegetation)
- Amending Clause 66 (Referral and Notice Provisions)
- Amending Clause 81.01 (Table of Documents Incorporated in this Scheme).

The Amendment also updates schedules to Clause 52.17 in the Alpine, Ballarat, Benalla, Buloke, Campaspe, Central Goldfields, Colac Otway, Gannawarra, Greater Bendigo, Greater Shepparton, Hepburn, Indigo, Loddon, Macedon Ranges, Manningham, Mansfield, Mildura, Mitchell, Moira, Moorabool, Mount Alexander, Murrindindi, Nillumbik, Pyrenees, Strathbogie, Surf Coast, Swan Hill, Towong, Wangaratta, Wodonga, and Yarra Ranges Planning Schemes.
