Crown Land (Reserves) Act 1978

CROWN LAND (RESERVES) (ALBERT PARK RESERVE AND ALBERT RESERVE) AMENDMENT REGULATIONS 2017

I, Lily D'Ambrosio, Minister for Energy, Environment and Climate Change, make the following Regulations.

1 Objectives

The objectives of these Regulations are to amend the Crown Land (Reserves) (Albert Park Reserve and Albert Reserve) Regulations 2008 to convert the fees into fee units, within the meaning of the **Monetary Units Act 2004**, and to increase the maximum fees for use of a vehicle parking area.

2 Authorising provision

These Regulations are made under section 13 of the **Crown Land (Reserves) Act 1978**.

3 Commencement

These Regulations come into operation on 1 January 2018.

4 Principal Regulations

In these Regulations, the Crown Land (Reserves) (Albert Park Reserve and Albert Reserve) Regulations 2008 that were published in Special Government Gazette No. 333 on 3 December 2008 are called the Principal Regulations.

5 Expiry

These Regulations expire on 3 December 2018.

6 Definitions

In regulation 6 of the Principal Regulations **insert** the following definition –
'**fee units** means an amount in dollars equal to the product obtained by multiplying the number of fee units by the amount fixed from time to time by the Treasurer under section 5(3) of the **Monetary Units Act 2004**;'.

8 End Notes

After paragraph (1) in the end notes to the Principal Regulations, **insert** –

‘(1A) Fee Units

These Regulations provide for fees by reference to fee units within the meaning of the **Monetary Units Act 2004**. The amount of the fee is to be calculated, in accordance with section 7 of that Act, by multiplying the number of fee units applicable by the value of a fee unit.

The value of a fee unit for the financial year commencing 1 July 2017 is \$14.22. The amount of the calculated fee may be rounded to the nearest 10 cents.

The value of a fee unit for future financial years is to be fixed by the Treasurer under section 5 of the **Monetary Units Act 2004**. The value of a fee unit for a financial year must be published in the Government Gazette and a Victorian newspaper before 1 June in the preceding financial year.’
