Road Management Act 2004

DESIGNATION OF TOW AWAY AREA UNDER SCHEDULE 4 CLAUSE 5

2017 Moomba Festival - City of Melbourne

Clause 5 of Schedule 4 to the **Road Management Act 2004** provides that a State road authority may move, keep or impound any vehicle that is unlawfully parked or left standing in an area designated by the Minister, (referred to in this instrument as a 'tow-away area'), and may charge the owner of the vehicle a reasonable fee.

For the purposes of that provision, I, John Merritt, Chief Executive of the Roads Corporation and delegate of the Minister for Roads, designate the locations specified and shown on the attached plan, to be a tow-away area to facilitate the 2017 Moomba Festival, to be held in and around the City of Melbourne.


This instrument takes effect at 12.00 pm on Sunday 12 March 2017 and expires at 5.00 pm on Monday 13 March 2017 for the following roads:

- Dodds Street, Southbank Boulevard to Grant Street (both sides)
- Swanston Street, between Flinders Street and Princes Bridge (southbound only)
- Princes Bridge (southbound only)
- St Kilda Road, between Princes Bridge and Domain Road (eastern side southbound service road only)
- Southbank Boulevard, between St Kilda Road and Dodds Street (south side only).

This instrument takes effect at 5.00 pm on Sunday 12 March 2017 and expires at 5.00 pm on Monday 13 March 2017 for the following roads:

• Domain Road, between St Kilda Road and Dallas Brooks Drive (both sides).
