# 1. Title

This Order is called the Administrative Arrangements Order (No. 229) 2018.

# 2. Authorising provision

This Order is made under section 3 of the Administrative Arrangements Act 1983.

## 3. Commencement

- (1) Subject to subclauses (2) and (3), this Order takes effect on 1 January 2019.
- (2) This Order, as it applies to or in respect of an item in Table 1 of the Schedule, takes effect on 29 November 2018.
- (3) This Order, as it applies to or in respect of an item in Table 2 of the Schedule, takes effect on 1 January 2019.

# 4. Definitions

In this Order –

'Body' means Minister, Department or officer;

'instrument' includes contract and agreement;

'**New Body**' means, in respect of an Old Body, the Body specified in Column 3 of the item specifying the Old Body in a Table of the Schedule;

'Old Body' means a Body specified in Column 1 of an item in a Table of the Schedule;

'Schedule' means the Schedule to this Order;

# 'transaction' includes -

- (a) agreement, bond, contract, deed or other consensual arrangement; and
- (b) action, appeal, arbitration, prosecution or other legal proceeding; and
- (c) assignment, charge, lease, mortgage, transfer or other dealing with property; and
- (d) loan, guarantee, indemnity or other dealing with money; and
- (e) approval, consent, delegation, direction, licence, order, permit, requirement or other authority; and
- (f) notice; and
- (g) any other act, entitlement or liability at law.

# SPECIAL

### 5. Construction of references

- (1) A reference to an Old Body in any one or more of the following is taken to be a reference to the New Body
  - (a) an Act or a provision of an Act specified in an item in a Table of the Schedule;
  - (b) a statutory instrument or other instrument made under an Act specified in an item in a Table of the Schedule;
  - (c) any other instrument specified in an item in a Table of the Schedule.
- (2) A reference to an Old Body in respect of any matter or thing done under an Act or a provision of an Act (other than the making of an instrument referred to in subclause (1) (b) or (c)) that is specified in an item in a Table of the Schedule is taken to be a reference to the New Body.
- (3) For the purposes of this clause, a reference to an Old Body acting jointly and severally in Column 1 of an item in a Table of the Schedule is to be read as a reference to that Old Body acting in one of the following ways (however described in a previous Order made under section 3 of the Administrative Arrangements Act 1983), as the case requires
  - (a) on its own;
  - (b) with another Old Body specified in that item;
  - (c) with 2 or more other Old Bodies specified in that item.
- (4) For the purposes of this clause, a reference to an Old Body acting jointly in Column 1 of an item in a Table of the Schedule is to be read as a reference to that Old Body acting in one of the following ways (however described in a previous Order made under section 3 of the Administrative Arrangements Act 1983), as the case requires
  - (a) with another Old Body specified in that item;
  - (b) with 2 or more other Old Bodies specified in that item.

### 6. Saving of existing transactions

If a transaction happened in relation to an Old Body before this Order takes effect in respect of the item specifying the Old Body -

- (a) the transaction continues as if this Order were not made; and
- (b) the transaction may be given effect to, or enforced or completed, by or in relation to the New Body in the same way as it would have been given effect to, or enforced or completed, by or in relation to the Old Body.

### 7. Keeping financial accounts and reports

- (1) Despite this Order taking effect in respect of items 38, 39, 57, 58, 59 and 60 specified in Table 2 of the Schedule, the Secretary to the Department of Economic Development, Jobs, Transport and Resources must ensure, for the purposes of the Financial Management Act 1994, that, during the period starting on 1 July 2018 and ending on 31 December 2018, financial accounts are kept and reports are provided in relation to a function under an Act specified in items 38, 39, 57, 58, 59 and 60 that is transferred to the Secretary to the Department of Premier and Cabinet.
- (2) Despite this Order taking effect in respect of items 32, 33, 34, 35, 36, 37, 43, 44, 45, 46, 47, 48, 49, 50, 53, 54, 55, 56, 57, 58, 59 and 60 specified in Table 2 of the Schedule, the Secretary to the Department of Economic Development, Jobs, Transport and Resources must ensure, for the purposes of the Financial Management Act 1994, that, during the period starting on 1 July 2018 and ending on 31 December 2018, financial accounts are kept and reports are provided in relation to a function under an Act specified in items 32, 33, 34, 35, 36, 37, 43, 44, 45, 46, 47, 48, 49, 50, 53, 54, 55, 56, 57, 58, 59 and 60 that is transferred to the Secretary to the Department of Jobs, Precincts and Regions.

- (3) Despite this Order taking effect in respect of items 57, 58, 59 and 60 specified in Table 2 of the Schedule, the Secretary to the Department of Premier and Cabinet must ensure, for the purposes of the Financial Management Act 1994, that, during the period starting on 1 July 2018 and ending on 31 December 2018, financial accounts are kept and reports are provided in relation to a function under an Act specified items 57, 58, 59 and 60 that is transferred to the Secretary to the Department of Jobs, Precincts and Regions.
- (4) Despite this Order taking effect in respect of items 36, 37, 61, 62, 63 and 64 specified in Table 2 of the Schedule, the Secretary to the Department of Economic Development, Jobs, Transport and Resources must ensure, for the purposes of the Financial Management Act 1994, that, during the period starting on 1 July 2018 and ending on 31 December 2018, financial accounts are kept and reports are provided in relation to a function under an Act specified in items 36, 37, 61, 62, 63 and 64 that is transferred to the Secretary to the Department of Treasury and Finance.
- (5) Despite this Order taking effect in respect of items 49, 50, 51, 52, 53 and 54 specified in Table 2 of the Schedule, the Secretary to the Department of Economic Development, Jobs, Transport and Resources must ensure, for the purposes of the Financial Management Act 1994, that, during the period starting on 1 July 2018 and ending on 31 December 2018, financial accounts are kept and reports are provided in relation to a function under an Act specified in items 49, 50, 51, 52, 53 and 54 that is transferred to the Secretary to the Department of Environment, Land, Water and Planning.
- (6) Despite this Order taking effect in respect of items 43, 44, 45,46, 47 and 48 specified in Table 2 of the Schedule, the Secretary to the Department of Economic Development, Jobs, Transport and Resources must ensure, for the purposes of the Financial Management Act 1994, that, during the period starting on 1 July 2018 and ending on 31 December 2018, financial accounts are kept and reports are provided in relation to a function under an Act specified in items 43, 44, 45, 46, 47 and 48 that is transferred to the Secretary to the Department of Education and Training.
- (7) Despite this Order taking effect in respect of items 34, 35, 40, 41, 42, 51, 52, 59, 60, 61, 62, 63 and 64 specified in Table 2 of the Schedule, the Secretary to the Department of Economic Development, Jobs, Transport and Resources must ensure, for the purposes of the Financial Management Act 1994, that, during the period starting on 1 July 2018 and ending on 31 December 2018, financial accounts are kept and reports are provided in relation to a function under an Act specified in items 34, 35, 40, 41, 42, 51, 52, 59, 60, 61, 62, 63 and 64 that is transferred to the Secretary to the Department of Transport.
- (8) Despite this Order taking effect in respect of items 55 and 56 specified in Table 2 of the Schedule, the Secretary to the Department of Economic Development, Jobs, Transport and Resources must ensure, for the purposes of the Financial Management Act 1994, that, during the period starting on 1 July 2018 and ending on 31 December 2018, financial accounts are kept and reports are provided in relation to a function under an Act specified in items 55 and 56 that is transferred to the Secretary to the Department of Health and Human Services.
- (9) Despite this Order taking effect in respect of items 43, 44, 45, 46, 47, 48, 65 and 66 specified in Table 2 of the Schedule, the Secretary to the Department of Education and Training must ensure, for the purposes of the Financial Management Act 1994, that, during the period starting on 1 July 2018 and ending on 31 December 2018, financial accounts are kept and reports are provided in relation to a function under an Act specified in items 43, 44, 45, 46, 47, 48, 65 and 66 that is transferred to the Secretary to the Department of Jobs, Precincts and Regions.

- (10) Despite this Order taking effect in respect of items 49, 50, 53, 54, 67 and 68 specified in Table 2 of the Schedule, the Secretary to the Department of Environment, Land, Water and Planning must ensure, for the purposes of the Financial Management Act 1994, that, during the period starting on 1 July 2018 and ending on 31 December 2018, financial accounts are kept and reports are provided in relation to a function under an Act specified in items 49, 50, 53, 54, 67 and 68 that is transferred to the Secretary to the Department of Jobs, Precincts and Regions.
- (11) Despite this Order taking effect in respect of items 71, 72, 79, 80, 81, 82, 85, 86, 87, 88, 89 and 90 specified in Table 2 of the Schedule, the Secretary to the Department of Health and Human Services must ensure, for the purposes of the Financial Management Act 1994, that, during the period starting on 1 July 2018 and ending on 31 December 2018, financial accounts are kept and reports are provided in relation to a function under an Act specified in items 71, 72, 79, 80, 81, 82, 85, 86, 87, 88, 89 and 90 that is transferred to the Secretary to the Department of Justice and Community Safety.
- (12) Despite this Order taking effect in respect of items 57, 58, 73, 74, 77 and 78 specified in Table 2 of the Schedule, the Secretary to the Department of Health and Human Services must ensure, for the purposes of the Financial Management Act 1994, that, during the period starting on 1 July 2018 and ending on 31 December 2018, financial accounts are kept and reports are provided in relation to a function under an Act specified in items 57, 58, 73, 74, 77 and 78 that is transferred to the Secretary to the Department of Premier and Cabinet.
- (13) Despite this Order taking effect in respect of items 69, 70, 71, 72 and 73 specified in Table 2 of the Schedule, the Secretary to Department of Health and Human Services must ensure, for the purposes of the Financial Management Act 1994, that, during the period starting on 1 July 2018 and ending on 31 December 2018, financial accounts are kept and reports are provided in relation to a function under an Act specified in items 69, 70, 71, 72 and 73 that is transferred to the Secretary to the Department of Education and Training.
- (14) Despite this Order taking effect in respect of items 55, 56, 57, 58, 75 and 76 specified in Table 2 of the Schedule, the Secretary to the Department of Health and Human Services must ensure, for the purposes of the Financial Management Act 1994, that, during the period starting on 1 July 2018 and ending on 31 December 2018, financial accounts are kept and reports are provided in relation to a function under an Act specified in items 55, 56, 57, 58, 75 and 76 that is transferred to the Secretary to the Department of Jobs, Precincts and Regions.
- (15) Despite this Order taking effect in respect of items 79, 80, 83, 84, 85 and 86 specified in Table 2 of the Schedule, the Secretary to the Department of Justice and Regulation must ensure, for the purposes of the Financial Management Act 1994, that, during the period starting on 1 July 2018 and ending on 31 December 2018, financial accounts are kept and reports are provided in relation to a function under an Act specified in items 79, 80, 83, 84, 85 and 86 that is transferred to the Secretary to the Department of Health and Human Services.
- (16) Despite this Order taking effect in respect of items 91, 92, 93 and 94 specified in Table 2 of the Schedule, the Secretary to the Department of Justice and Regulation must ensure, for the purposes of the Financial Management Act 1994, that, during the period starting on 1 July 2018 and ending on 31 December 2018, financial accounts are kept and reports are provided in relation to a function under an Act specified in items 91, 92, 93 and 94 that is transferred to the Secretary to the Department of Jobs, Precincts and Regions.

- (17) Despite this Order taking effect in respect of items 79, 80, 81, 82, 85, 86, 87, 88, 93, 94, 95, 96, 97, 98, 99 and 100 specified in Table 2 of the Schedule, the Secretary to the Department of Justice and Regulation must ensure, for the purposes of the Financial Management Act 1994, that, during the period starting on 1 July 2018 and ending on 31 December 2018, financial accounts are kept and reports are provided in relation to a function under an Act specified in items 79, 80, 81, 82, 85, 86, 87, 88, 93, 94, 95, 96, 97, 98, 99 and 100 that is transferred to the Secretary to the Department of Justice and Community Safety.
- (18) Despite this Order taking effect in respect of items 51 and 52 specified in Table 2 of the Schedule, the Secretary to the Department of Environment, Land, Water and Planning must ensure, for the purposes of the Financial Management Act 1994, that, during the period starting on 1 July 2018 and ending on 31 December 2018, financial accounts are kept and reports are provided in relation to a function under an Act specified in items 51 and 52 that is transferred to the Secretary to the Department of Transport.
- (19) Despite this Order taking effect in respect of items 59 and 60 specified in Table 2 of the Schedule, the Secretary to the Department of Premier and Cabinet must ensure, for the purposes of the Financial Management Act 1994, that, during the period starting on 1 July 2018 and ending on 31 December 2018, financial accounts are kept and reports are provided in relation to a function under an Act specified in items 59 and 60 that is transferred to the Secretary to the Department of Transport.
- (20) Despite this Order taking effect in respect of items 99 and 100 specified in Table 2 of the Schedule, the Secretary to the Department of Justice and Regulation must ensure, for the purposes of the Financial Management Act 1994, that, during the period starting on 1 July 2018 and ending on 31 December 2018, financial accounts are kept and reports are provided in relation to a function under an Act specified in items 99 and 100 that is transferred to the Secretary to the Department of Treasury and Finance.
- (21) Despite this Order taking effect in respect of items 101 and 102 specified in Table 2 of the Schedule, the Secretary to the Department of Treasury and Finance must ensure, for the purposes of the Financial Management Act 1994, that, during the period starting on 1 July 2018 and ending on 31 December 2018, financial accounts are kept and reports are provided in relation to a function under an Act specified in items 101 and 102 that is transferred to the Secretary to the Department of Justice and Community Safety.
- (22) Despite this Order taking effect in respect of items 61, 62, 63 and 64 specified in Table 2 of the Schedule, the Secretary to the Department of Treasury and Finance must ensure, for the purposes of the Financial Management Act 1994, that, during the period starting from 1 July 2018 and ending on 31 December 2018, financial accounts are kept and reports are provided in relation to a function under an Act specified in items 61, 62, 63 and 64 that is transferred to the Secretary to the Department of Transport.

### 8. Providing financial accounts and reports

For the purpose of enabling a Secretary to a Department that is an Old Body specified in an item of a Table in the Schedule to comply with clause 7, the Secretary to a Department that is the New Body to which a function referred to in that clause is transferred, must, if requested by the Old Body, provide that Old Body with any financial accounts and records or other information.
