Road Management Act 2004

DESIGNATION OF TOW-AWAY AREA UNDER SCHEDULE 4 CLAUSE 5

Tow-Away Area for Victoria Street Lunar Festival 2019

Clause 5 of Schedule 4 to the **Road Management Act 2004** provides that a State road authority may move, keep or impound any vehicle that is unlawfully parked or left standing in an area designated by the Minister (referred to in this instrument as a 'tow-away area'), and may charge the owner of the vehicle a reasonable fee.

For the purposes of that provision, I, Anita Curnow, Executive Director Access and Operations of the Roads Corporation and delegate of the Minister for Roads and Road Safety, designate the locations specified and shown on the attached plan, to be a tow-away area to facilitate the traffic management for the Victoria Street Lunar Festival 2019.


This instrument takes effect at 4.00 pm on Saturday 19 January 2019 and expires at 5.00 am on Monday 21 January 2019.
