NOTICE OF PREPARATION OF REGULATORY IMPACT STATEMENT

Estate Agents (Fees) Regulations 2018

Notice is given that, in accordance with section 11 of the **Subordinate Legislation Act 1994**, a Regulatory Impact Statement (RIS) has been prepared for the proposed Estate Agents (Fees) Regulations 2018 (the proposed Regulations).

The proposed Regulations, to be made under the **Estate Agents Act 1980**, are intended to replace the Estate Agents (Fees) Regulations 2007, which sunset on 16 July 2018.

The objective of the proposed Regulations is to prescribe licence fees and other fees for the purposes of the **Estate Agents Act 1980** to meet the cost of administering the regulatory scheme for estate agents.

The RIS examines the impact of the proposed regulations and possible alternatives, and concludes that the proposed Regulations are the most efficient and equitable method of meeting the identified objectives.
