Governance Local Law 2018

At its Ordinary Meeting on 19 December 2018, Gannawarra Shire Council adopted its new Governance Local Law 2018. The Local Law incorporates by reference Procedure for the Election of Mayor and Meeting Procedures and commences operation on 4 January 2019. On the commencement of this Local Law, Council's Local Law No. 7 (2011) Processes of Local Government (Meetings and Common Seal), (Further Amendment) is revoked.

The objectives of this Local Law are to:

- (a) provide a mechanism to facilitate the good government of the Council through its formal meeting procedure to ensure effective and efficient Council decisions are made in a manner which acknowledges the role of local government within the Australian system of Government;
- (b) promote and encourage community participation in the system of local government by providing mechanisms for the Council to ascertain the community's views and expectations;
- (c) regulate and control the election of Mayor, any Deputy Mayor and the chairperson of any Special Committees;
- (d) regulate and control the procedures governing the conduct of meetings including –
 - (i) the notice required for meetings
 - (ii) the keeping of minutes;
- (e) regulate and control the use of the Council's seal;
- (f) provide for the administration of the Council's powers and functions;
- (g) provide generally for the peace, order and good government of the municipal district; and
- (h) repeal any redundant local laws.

DRUGS, POISONS AND CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES REGULATIONS 2017**Approval under Regulation 159A**

Pursuant to Regulation 159A of the Drugs, Poisons and Controlled Substances Regulations 2017, I, Bruce Bolam, Chief Preventive Health Officer, Prevention and Population Health and Delegate of the Secretary of the Department of Health and Human Services, hereby approve the qualification and the course listed below to possess and administer a Schedule 4 poison by a dental assistant.

Approved Dental Assisting Qualification and Course

This approval applies to a dental assistant who is to possess and administer the Schedule 4 poison fluoride varnish (example Duraphat Varnish 5% w/v Sodium Fluoride Varnish tube)² under an approval issued under Regulation 160 and is employed or engaged in a public dental service declared under Regulation 160A, and has satisfactorily completed the following qualification and course:

- HLT45015 – Certificate IV in Dental Assisting
- HLTOHC006 – Apply fluoride varnish

Education and Training Reform Act 2006

Pursuant to section 2.6.29 of the **Education and Training Reform Act 2006** ('the Act') a person who is registered as a teacher or early childhood teacher under Part 2.6 of the Act ceases to be so registered and is disqualified from teaching in a school or early childhood service if the person is convicted or found guilty in Victoria or elsewhere of a sexual offence as defined by the Act.

On 14 December 2018, Kathryn Joy Woods, 59 year old female, was convicted of sexual offences in Victoria. The offences included indecently assaulting a child under the age of 16 years contrary to section 44(1) of the **Crimes Act 1958** as in force between 26 December 1984 and 30 January 1985; and committing gross indecency with a child under the age of 16 years contrary to section 50(1) of the **Crimes Act 1958** as in force between 26 December 1984 and 30 January 1985. On this day, being 14 December 2018, Kathryn Woods ceased to be a registered teacher in accordance with section 2.6.29(1) of the Act and was disqualified from teaching in a school or an early childhood service in accordance with section 2.6.29(3) of the Act.
