## **Health Services Act 1988**

AN ORDER FOR THE AMALGAMATION OF KYNETON DISTRICT HEALTH SERVICE AND HEPBURN HEALTH SERVICE TO BE KNOWN AS CENTRAL HIGHLANDS RURAL HEALTH

Order in Council

The Governor in Council, under the following sections of the **Health Services Act 1988** (the Act):

- Directs, pursuant to section 65(1) of the Act, that Kyneton District Health Service and Hepburn Health Service be amalgamated;
- Declares, pursuant to section 65(4) of the Act, that the new registered funded agency named Central Highlands Rural Health shall be a Schedule 1 public hospital;
- Provide, pursuant to section 65(3) of the Act that employees of Kyneton District Health Service and Hepburn Health Service, will on the date of amalgamation, become employees of the newly amalgamated Central Highlands Rural Health; and
- Amends Schedule 1 of the Act, pursuant to section 8(1)(b) of the Act, such that the names Kyneton District Health Service and Hepburn Health Service be removed and replaced with Central Highlands Rural Health.

The Order is to come into effect on 30 November 2019.
