### MAJOR SPORTING EVENT ORDER FOR THE 2020 AND 2021 AUSTRALIAN OPEN TENNIS TOURNAMENTS

#### Order in Council

The Governor in Council under section 7 of the **Major Events Act 2009** (the Act) specifies each of the matters in Column 2 of Table 1 in accordance with the corresponding section of the Act in Column 1 of Table 1.

8(1)(b) Event venue:	National Tennis Centre Land
8(2)(a) Event organiser:	Tennis Australia Ltd. ABN 61 006 281 125
8(2)(i) Parts of the Act to apply:	Part 3 (Commercial Arrangements)
8(2)(h) Commercial Arrangements Period:	From the date of the Order until one month after the final day of each Tournament in 2020 and 2021.

This Order comes into effect on the date that it is published in the Government Gazette.
