#### Order in Council

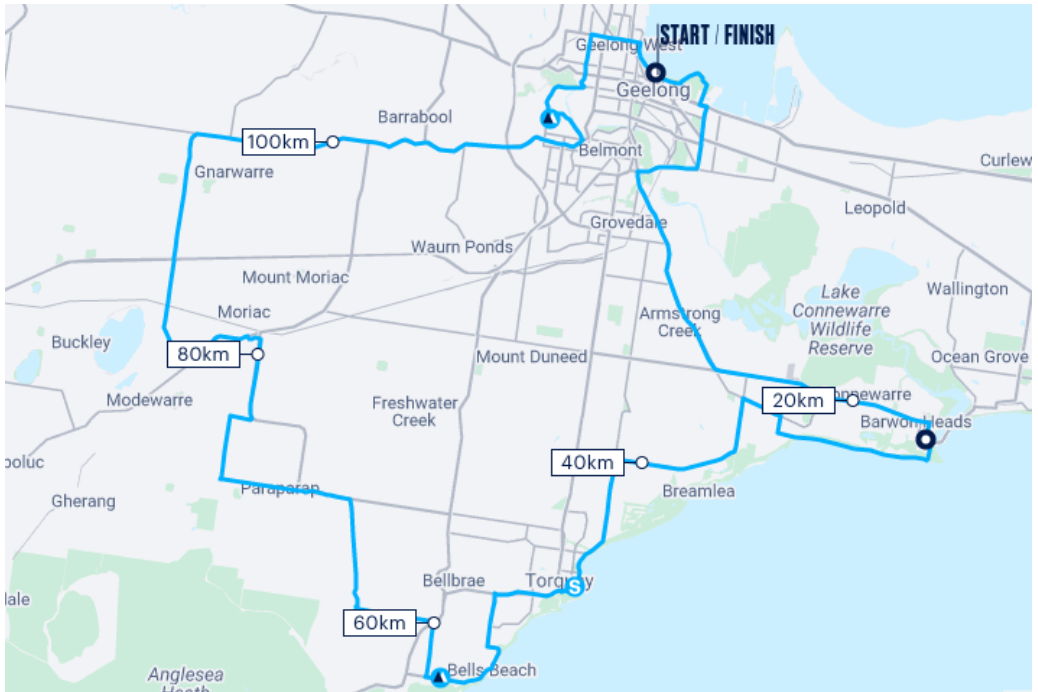

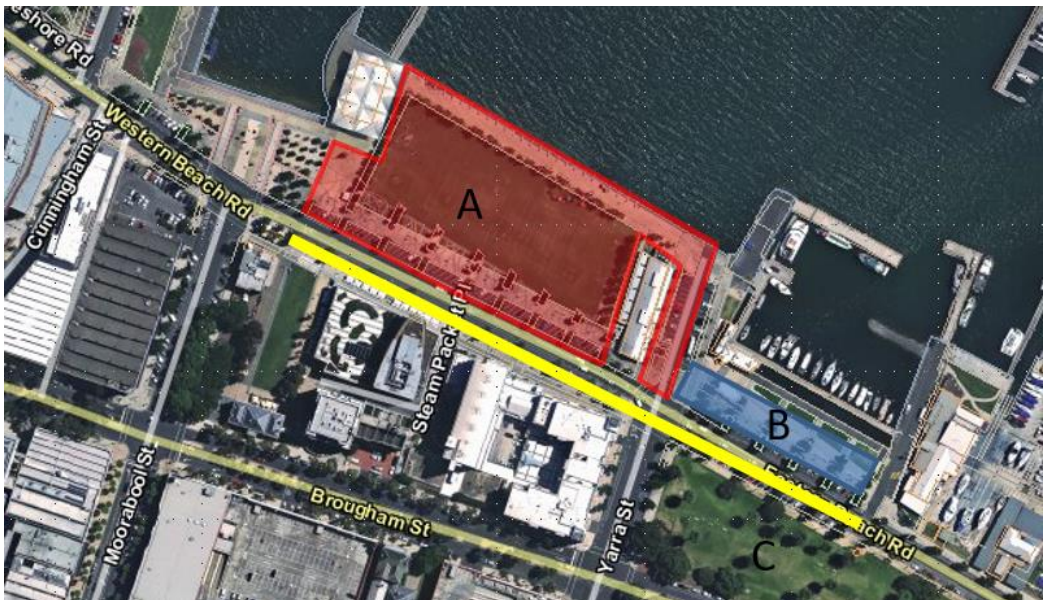

**(EVENT VENUE)**

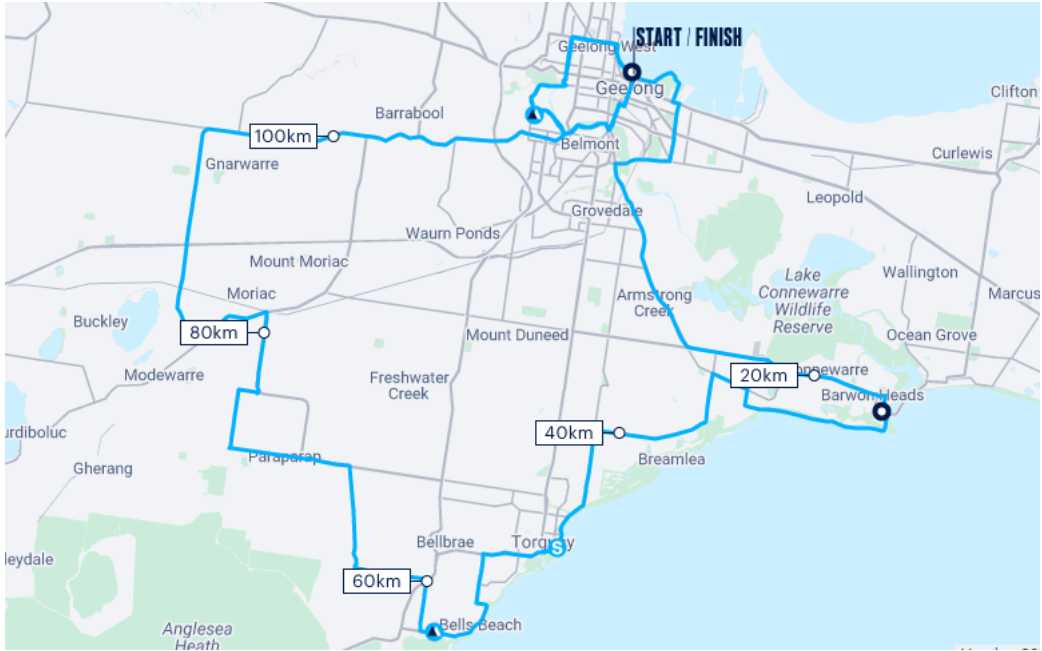


**PLAN 1(b)**

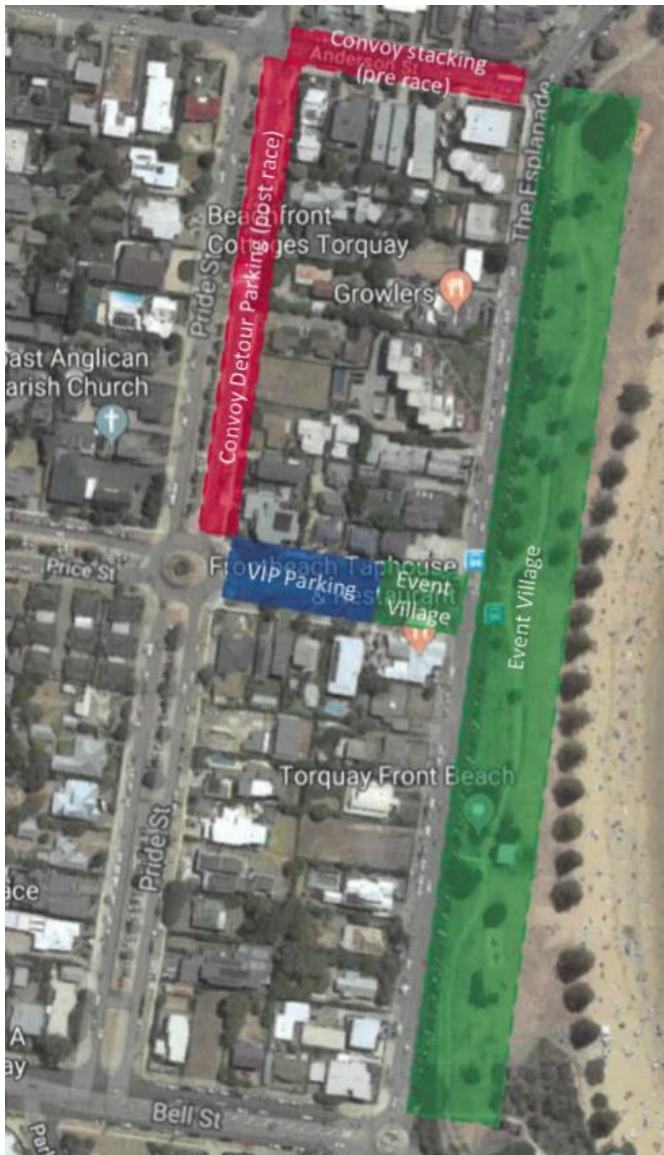




**PLAN 3(a)**
