## Road Management Act 2004

## DESIGNATION OF TOW-AWAY AREA UNDER SCHEDULE 4 CLAUSE 5

Tow-Away Area for 2020 Victoria Street Lunar Festival

Clause 5 of Schedule 4 to the **Road Management Act 2004** provides that a State road authority may move, keep or impound any vehicle that is unlawfully parked or left standing in an area designated by the Minister (referred to in this instrument as a 'tow-away area'), and may charge the owner of the vehicle a reasonable fee.


For the purposes of that provision, I, Keith Weegberg, Manager Real Time Operations (Roads) of the Department of Transport and delegate of the Minister for Roads, designate the locations specified and shown on the attached plan, to be a tow-away area to facilitate the traffic management for the 2020 Victoria Street Lunar Festival.

This instrument takes effect at 4.00 pm on Saturday 18 January 2020 and expires at 5.00 am on Monday 20 January 2020.

• Victoria Street between Hoddle Street and Church Street, Richmond.
