



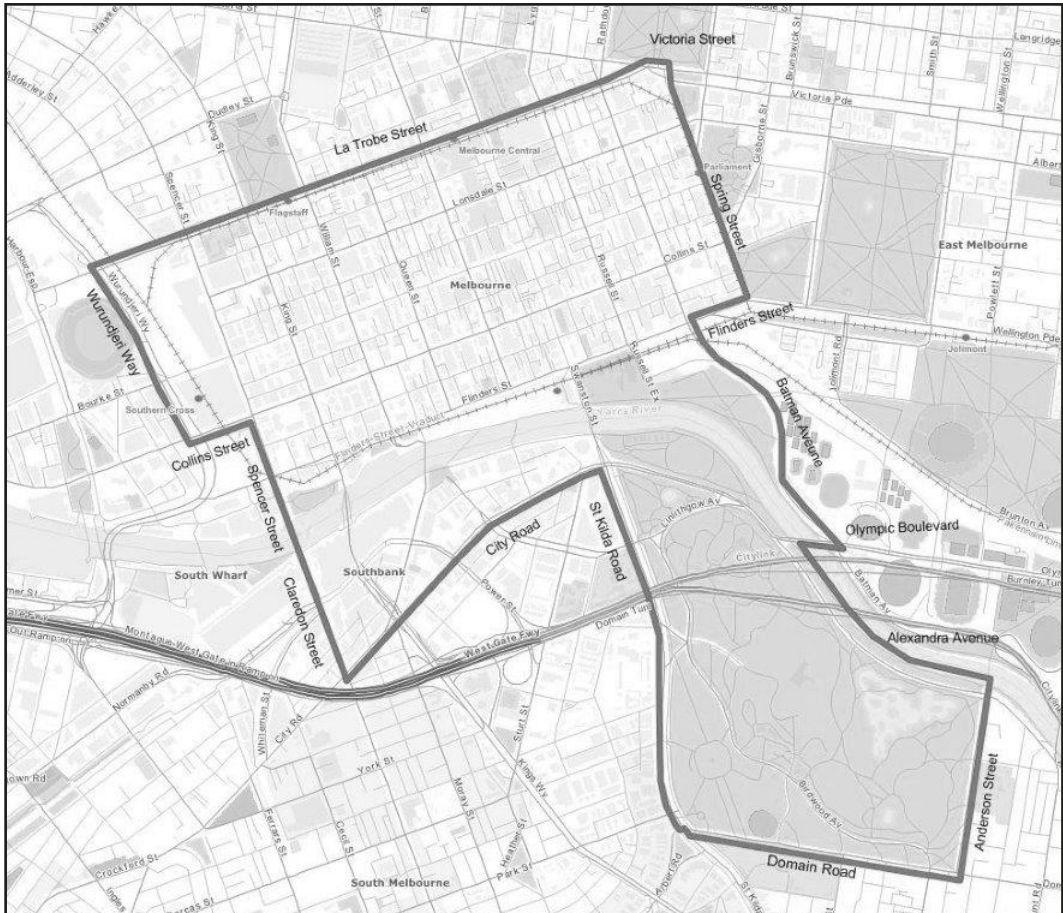

## Control of Weapons Act 1990

### DECLARATION OF DESIGNATED AREA UNDER SECTION 10D(1)

The Assistant Commissioner, North West Metro, acting as a delegate of the Chief Commissioner of Police under section 10D(1) of the **Control of Weapons Act 1990**, declares as a designated area: all public places within the area bounded by and including, the intersection of Domain Road and Anderson Street, to the intersection of Anderson Street and Alexandra Avenue and Olympic Boulevard, to the intersection of Olympic Boulevard and Batman Avenue, to the intersection of Batman Avenue and Flinders Street, to the intersection of Flinders Street and Spring Street, to the intersection of Spring Street and Victoria Street, to the intersection of Victoria Street and Latrobe Street, to the intersection of Latrobe Street and Wurundjeri Way, to the intersection of Wurundjeri Way and Collins Street, to the intersection of Collins Street and Spencer Street, to the intersection of Clarendon Street and City Road, to the intersection of City Road and St Kilda Road, to the intersection of St Kilda Road and Domain Road, to the intersection of Domain Road and Anderson Street. For the removal of doubt, this area includes Federation Square, Birrarung Marr, Alexandra Gardens, Flinders Street Railway Station and Melbourne Central Railway Station.



**SPECIAL**

This declaration will operate on:

Friday 8 March 2019 from 4.00 pm to Saturday 9 March 2019 at 4.00 am;

Saturday the 9 March 2019 from 4.00 pm to Sunday 10 March 2019 at 4.00 am;

Sunday 10 March 2019 from 4.00 pm to Monday 11 March 2019 at 4.00 am;

Monday 11 March 2019 from 4.00pm to Tuesday 12 March 2019 at 2.00am.

During these times members of the police force are authorised to exercise the following powers:

- (a) in a public place in the designated area, without warrant, stop and search for weapons or request:
  - (i) any person;
  - (ii) anything in the possession or control of the person;
  - (iii) any vehicle with a person in or on the vehicle; and
  - (iv) anything in or on such vehicle;
- (b) detain a person or vehicle for so long as is reasonably necessary to conduct a search;
- (c) seize and detain any item the member reasonably suspects is a weapon;
- (d) request a person who is the subject of a full search to disclose his or her identity; and
- (e) request the removal of any article covering a person's face or direct that person to leave the designated area if said person refuses to remove the face covering, or if the police officer reasonably believes that said person intends to engage in conduct that would constitute an affray under section 195H, **Crimes Act 1958** or violent disorder under section 195I, **Crimes Act 1958**.
