## Road Safety Act 1986

EXEMPTION FROM SECTION 65A(1) OF THE **ROAD SAFETY ACT 1986** FOR PERSONS PARTICIPATING IN THE FILMING OF KLAUS TV SERIES AT FRANKLIN STREET AND ANTHONY STREET, MELBOURNE

#### 1 Purpose

The purpose of this notice is to exempt persons from section 65A(1) of the **Road Safety Act** 1986 while participating in the filming of Klaus TV series at Franklin Street and Anthony Street, Melbourne.

## 2 Authorising provision

This notice is made under section 65A(3) of the Road Safety Act 1986.

Section 65A(1) of the **Road Safety Act 1986** provides that a person must not drive a motor vehicle in a manner which causes the motor vehicle to undergo loss of traction by one or more of the motor vehicle's wheels. (Penalty: 5 penalty units)

Section 65A(3)(c) empowers the Minister to declare, by notice published in the Victoria Government Gazette, that the offence in section 65A(1) does not apply to persons while participating in an activity, event or function or a class of activities, events or functions specified in the declaration.

#### 3 Commencement

This notice takes effect at 11.00 am on 10 April 2019.

## 4 Expiry

This notice expires at 3.30 pm on 10 April 2019.

## 5. Definitions

In this notice, unless the context or subject-matter otherwise requires –

- a) 'Event' means filming of Klaus TV series;
- b) 'Event Location' means Franklin Street and Anthony Street, Melbourne;
- Event Dates' means 10 April 2019 until 10 April 2019 between the hours of 11.00 am and 3.00 pm.

## 6 Declaration

For the purposes of section 65A(3) of the **Road Safety Act 1986**, I, Robyn Seymour, as delegate for the Minister for Roads declare that section 65A(1) of the **Road Safety Act 1986** does not apply to a person while participating in the Event at the Event Location on the Event Dates provided that –
