Health Services Act 1988

AN ORDER FOR THE AMALGAMATION OF NUMURKAH AND DISTRICT HEALTH SERVICE, COBRAM DISTRICT HEALTH AND NATHALIA DISTRICT HOSPITAL TO BE KNOWN AS NCN HEALTH

Order in Council

The Governor in Council, under the following sections of the **Health Services Act 1988** (the Act):

- Directs, pursuant to section 65(1) of the Act, that Numurkah and District Health Service, Cobram District Health and Nathalia District Hospital be amalgamated;
- Declares, pursuant to section 65(4) of the Act, that the new registered funded agency named NCN Health shall be a Schedule 1 public hospital;
- Provide, pursuant to section 65(3) of the Act that employees of Numurkah and District Health Service, Cobram District Health and Nathalia District Hospital, will on the date of amalgamation, become employees of the newly amalgamated NCN Health;
- Amends Schedule 1 of the Act, pursuant to section 8(1)(b) of the Act, such that the names Numurkah and District Health Service, Cobram District Health and Nathalia District Hospital be removed and replaced with NCN Health.

The Order is to come into effect on 1 July 2019.
