APPOINTMENT OF A MEMBER TO THE COUNCIL OF THE VICTORIAN INSTITUTE OF TEACHING SCHEDULE TO THE ORDER IN COUNCIL

1. Appointment Arrangements

The appointment is on a part-time basis.

2. Period of Appointment

The appointment is from the date of the Order in Council until 31 May 2022 (both dates inclusive).

3. Duties and Responsibilities of the Position

The Council of the Victorian Institute of Teaching manages the affairs of the Victorian Institute of Teaching and exercises the powers of the Institute.

4. Termination Arrangements

Section 2.6.62(1) of the **Education and Training Reform Act 2006** (the Act) provides that a member of the Council may resign from office in writing to the Chairperson of the Council of the Victorian Institute of Teaching.

Under section 2.6.62(2) of the Act, the Governor in Council may at any time remove a member appointed by the Governor in Council from office.

5. Payment Provisions

The appointee holds a full-time position in the teaching service and so is not entitled to receive remuneration or fees (see clause 3(1) of Schedule 2 of the Act).

6. Superannuation Obligations

Not applicable because the appointee is not entitled to receive remuneration or fees.

7. Travel and Personal Expenses Arrangements

Members of the Council of the Victorian Institute of Teaching are entitled to reimbursement of reasonable travelling and personal expenses incurred consistent with the policies of the Department of Education and Training.

8. Leave Arrangements

Not applicable.

9. Prior Service

Not applicable.
