Freedom of Information Act 1982 STATEMENT UNDER FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 1982

In accordance with section 65AB(2) of the **Freedom of Information Act 1982** (FOI Act), I provide the following brief statement of reasons for Monash University (University) seeking leave under section 148 of the **Victorian Civil and Administrative Tribunal Act 1998** to appeal on a question of law from an order of the Victorian Civil and Administrative Tribunal (Tribunal) on 3 April 2020 in the matter of EBT v Monash University [2020] VCAT 440:

Monash University's brief statement of reasons:

- 1. Leave to appeal against the orders of the Tribunal has been sought because the University believes the Tribunal made errors of law regarding the proper construction and application of:
 - (a) section 19 of the FOI Act; and
 - (b) Item 7 of the Schedule to the Freedom of Information (Access Charges) Regulations 2014 (Regulations).
- 2. These provisions, section 19 of the FOI Act and Item 7 of the Schedule to the Regulations, have become more relevant to both agencies and FOI applicants and require further consideration as an increasing amount of information is stored electronically by agencies. There is a public interest in ensuring these provisions are properly construed and applied.
- 3. Determination of the questions of law raised in this appeal would clarify the proper construction and application of:
 - (a) section 19 of the FOI Act, to determine when information is not available in discrete form in documents of an agency, requiring the agency to produce a written document from that information; and
 - (b) Item 7 of the Schedule to the Regulations, to determine when access charges are payable under that item.
