NOTICE OF PREPARATION OF REGULATORY IMPACT STATEMENT

Proposed Estate Agents (Education) Regulations 2020

Notice is given that, in accordance with section 11 of the **Subordinate Legislation Act 1994**, a Regulatory Impact Statement (RIS) has been prepared for the proposed Estate Agents (Education) Regulations 2020 (the proposed Regulations).

The proposed Regulations, to be made under the **Estate Agents Act 1980**, are intended to replace the Estate Agents (Education) Interim Regulations 2019.

The objectives of the proposed Regulations are to:

- prescribe the courses of instruction for the licensing of estate agents;
- prescribe the courses of instruction for eligibility to be employed as an agent's representative; and
- provide for certain exemptions.

The RIS examines the impact of the proposed Regulations and possible alternatives, and concludes that the proposed Regulations are the most efficient method of meeting the identified objectives.
