NOTICE OF PREPARATION OF REGULATORY IMPACT STATEMENT

Guardianship and Administration (Fees) Regulations 2022

Notice is given in accordance with section 11 of the **Subordinate Legislation Act 1994** that a Regulatory Impact Statement (RIS) has been prepared in relation to the proposed Guardianship and Administration (Fees) Regulations 2022 (the proposed Regulations).

The proposed Regulations, to be made under section 194 of the **Guardianship and Administration Act 2019** (the Act), will replace the Guardianship and Administration (Fees) Regulations 2019 which expire on 28 February 2022.

The objective of the proposed Regulations is to set the annual fee to be paid by estates which are the subject of an administration order made under the Act.

The RIS examines the impact of the proposed Regulations against other fee options and concludes that the proposed Regulations are the most equitable and efficient method of achieving the identified objectives.

Public comments are invited on the RIS and the proposed Regulations. All comments must be in writing and received no later than 5.00 pm on Monday 10 January 2022.
