DESIGNATION OF TOW AWAY AREA UNDER SCHEDULE 4 CLAUSE 5

Tow Away Area for 2022 Victoria Street Lunar Festival

Clause 5 of Schedule 4 to the **Road Management Act 2004** provides that a State road authority may move, keep or impound any vehicle that is unlawfully parked or left standing in an area designated by the Minister, (referred to in this instrument as a 'tow-away area'), and may charge the owner of the vehicle a reasonable fee.

For the purposes of that provision, I, Angela Grice, Executive Director Planned Disruptions at the Department of Transport and delegate of the Minister for Roads, designate the locations specified and shown on the attached plan, to be a tow-away area to facilitate the 2022 Victoria Street Lunar Festival to be held in Richmond.


This instrument takes effect at 4.00 pm on Saturday, 22 January 2022 and expires at 5.00 am on Monday, 24 January 2022.
