Barwon River, Barwon Heads Sailing Association Events Exemption from Certain Rules

Date: Effective from 26 December 2021

Details: Mariners are advised that Barwon Heads Sailing Association organised and scheduled boating activity events in the Barwon River north of the Barwon Heads Bridge, part of the waters of the Local Port of Barwon Heads from 26 December 2021 to 15 May 2022 are exempt from certain rules of the **Marine Safety Act 2010**, Marine Safety Regulations 2012 and the waterway rules as detailed here;

1. Vessels associated with the Barwon Heads Sailing Association 2021–2022 calendar events are exempt from the requirements to operate a vessel at a speed not exceeding 5 knots:
 - (i) within 50 metres of another vessel;
 - (ii) within 200 metres of the waters' edge;
 - (iii) within 50 metres of wharf, jetty, slipway, diving platform or boat ramp;
 - (iv) within the 5 knot speed restriction zone
 as detailed in Clauses 2(c), 4(a), 4(b) and Clause 10.1 of Schedule 10 of the Vessel Operating and Zoning Rules.
2. The exemptions in Clause 1 above will apply only to operators and vessels associated with the event which are noted on a list of member participants maintained by Barwon Heads Sailing Association.

The exemptions apply for **only** the dates and times in Barwon Heads Sailing Association 2021–2022 calendar of events as attached in this notice:

- BHSA Summer Schedule 2021–2022
- BHSA Riversholme / Easter Race Schedule 2022

Mariners are advised to exercise caution when navigating in the Barwon River.

Mariners are further advised to monitor the forming wave conditions on the approach to the river entry at all times; mariners should be aware of submerged reef areas, Formby reef to the east and the fringing reef of the Barwon Head to the west.

DECLARATION OF BOATING ACTIVITY EXEMPTION

Barwon Coast Committee of Management as the declared waterway manager for Local Port of Barwon Heads, makes the following declaration under section 203(3) of the **Marine Safety Act 2010**.

For the purposes of boating activity conducted by Barwon Heads Sailing Association, persons and vessels involved in the Barwon Heads Sailing Association 2021/22 Race Schedule are exempt from the following requirements:

State Rules made under the Marine Act 1988

1. Clause 2(c) – must not exceed 5 knots within 50 metres of another vessel;
2. Clause 4(a) – must not exceed 5 knots within 200 metres of the water's edge;
3. Clause 4(b) – must not exceed 5 knots within 50 metres of a wharf, jetty, slipway, diving platform or boat ramp.

Waterway Rules made under the Marine Safety Act 2010 / Marine Act 1988

4. Clause 10.1 of Schedule 10 – 5 knot speed restriction on the waters of the Local Port of Barwon Heads.

Subject to the conditions detailed below:

- Masters of the rescue vessels are only exempt from 1–4 in the above list when undertaking a rescue operation to retrieve persons in distress, provide for their initial medical or other needs and deliver them to a place of safety on shore.
- Masters of participating vessels are exempt from 2–4 in the above list when engaging in competition and item 1 only when operating within 50 metres of another competing vessel. Participating vessels are those noted on a current membership list maintained by Barwon Heads Sailing Association.
- The exemptions apply for the dates tabled below in the Barwon Heads Sailing Association Race Schedule between 26 December 2021 and 15 May 2022.
- The exemptions apply provided the stated safety controls and undertakings detailed in the application form and associated documentation are adhered to.

ORDER PROHIBITING OR RESTRICTING THE ENTRY OR IMPORTATION INTO VICTORIA OF MATERIALS WHICH ARE HOSTS OF CUCUMBER GREEN MOTTLE MOSAIC VIRUS

I, Stephen Dibley, as delegate of the Minister for Agriculture, being of the reasonable suspicion that the exotic disease cucumber green mottle mosaic virus exists within Australia but outside Victoria, make the following Order.

1 Objective

The objective of this Order is to prohibit, restrict or impose conditions upon the entry or importation into Victoria of materials which are hosts of cucumber green mottle mosaic virus (CGMMV).

2 Authorising provision

This Order is made under section 36(1) of the **Plant Biosecurity Act 2010** (the Act).

3 Commencement

This Order comes into operation on the date of making.

4 Revocation

The Order entitled Order prohibiting or restricting the entry or importation into Victoria of materials which are hosts of cucumber green mottle mosaic virus made under section 36(1) of the **Plant Biosecurity Act 2010** and published in Victoria Government Gazette G3 on 21 January 2021 at pages 72–73 is **revoked**.

5 Definitions

In this Order –

host material means any host plant, agricultural machinery and packages used in association with the growing, harvesting and packaging of any host plant, or earth material from properties on which host plants have been grown.

host plant means any plant or plant product, excluding fruit, from the family *Cucurbitaceae*.

6 Prohibitions, restrictions and conditions

The following prohibitions, restrictions and conditions are specified in relation to the entry or importation of host material.

- (a) The entry or importation into Victoria of any host material is prohibited.
- (b) Subclause (a) does not apply if the host material –
 - (i) originates from a State or Territory that is known to be free of CGMMV; or
 - (ii) originates from an area for which there is currently in force an area freedom certificate issued by an officer responsible for agriculture in the State or Territory from which the material originated, certifying that the area from which the material originated is known to be free of CGMMV; or
 - (iii) is accompanied by a plant health certificate, assurance certificate or plant health declaration, certifying or declaring that the host material has been treated in a manner described in the Schedule to this Order; or
 - (iv) enters Victoria under and in accordance with a permit issued by an inspector and there is compliance with any conditions or requirements set out in the permit.

7 Verification

Where requested by an inspector, host material imported into Victoria which is required by clause 6(b)(iii) to be accompanied by a certificate or declaration, must be:

- (a) presented to an inspector for inspection; or
- (b) verified by a person accredited to do so by the Department of Jobs, Precincts and Regions.

8 Expiry

This Order remains in force for a period of 12 months from the date of making.

Schedule

Host material must –

1. In the case of host plants, be grown on the property, and have been sampled, tested and found free of CGMMV within the previous 12 months.
2. in the case of agricultural equipment and packages, be cleaned free of earth material and organic matter by –
 - (a) steam cleaning; or
 - (b) washing with high pressure hot water; or
 - (c) disinfection with a solution containing not less than 100 ppm available chlorine used as a spray rinse or drench treatment.

I, Stephen Dibley, as delegate of the Minister for Agriculture, being of the reasonable suspicion that the exotic pest fire ant exists within Australia but outside Victoria, make the following Order.

1 Objective

The objective of this Order is to prohibit, restrict or impose conditions upon the entry or importation into Victoria of materials which are hosts of fire ants.

2 Authorising provision

This Order is made under section 36(1) of the **Plant Biosecurity Act 2010** (the Act).

3 Commencement

This Order comes into force on the day of making.

4 Revocation

The Order entitled Order prohibiting or restricting the entry or importation into Victoria of materials which are hosts of fire ant made under section 36(1) of the **Plant Biosecurity Act 2010** and published in Victoria Government Gazette G24 on 17 June 2021 at pages 1239–1241 is **revoked**.

5 Definitions

In this Order –

‘**APVMA**’ means the Australian Pesticides and Veterinary Medicines Authority.

‘**fire ant**’ means the exotic pest red imported fire ant, *Solenopsis invicta* (Buren).

‘**host material**’ means any material capable of harbouring fire ants including plants, plant products, agricultural equipment, used packages, earth and landscaping materials, (including

potting media, organic mulch and composted animal manure) but excludes tissue culture, bare rooted plants washed free of earth material and seedlings in plugs/cells.

6 Prohibitions, restrictions and conditions

The following prohibitions, restrictions and conditions are specified in relation to the entry or importation of host material.

- (a) The entry or importation into Victoria of any host material is prohibited.
- (b) Sub-clause (a) does not apply if the host material –
 - (i) originates from an area for which there is currently in force an area freedom certificate issued by an officer responsible for agriculture in the State or Territory from which the material originated certifying that the area from which the material originated is known to be free of fire ants; or
 - (ii) is accompanied by a plant health certificate, assurance certificate or plant health declaration, certifying or declaring that the material has been treated in a manner described in the Schedule to this Order and where a copy of the certificate or declaration is forwarded to Agriculture Victoria at market.access@agriculture.vic.gov.au prior to despatch of the material; or
 - (iii) enters Victoria under and in accordance with a permit issued by an inspector and there is compliance with any conditions or requirements set out in the permit.

7 Verification of Consignments

Host material imported into Victoria which is required by clause 6(b)(ii) to be accompanied by a certificate or declaration must be –

- (a) presented to an Inspector for inspection; or
- (b) verified by a person accredited to do so by the Department of Jobs, Precincts and Regions.

8 Expiry

This Order remains in force for a period of 12 months after the date of making.

Schedule

Host material must –

- (1) in the case of containerised, potted and root-balled plants, trees and propagules –
 - (a) be grown in media treated with one of the following chemicals in accordance with the approved APVMA label or permit –
 - (i) a liquid mixture containing 500 g/L chlorpyrifos applied at 40 mL/100 L water by full immersion dip or drenching of the growing medium; or
 - (ii) a liquid mixture containing 80 g/L bifenthrin applied at 2.5 mL/L water as full immersion dip or drench, and plants consigned within 28 days; or
 - (iii) a liquid mixture containing 100 g/L bifenthrin applied at 2 mL/L water as full immersion dip or drench, and plants consigned within 28 days; or
 - (iv) a liquid mixture containing 240 g/L bifenthrin applied at 0.8 mL/L water as full immersion dip or drench, and plants consigned within 28 days; or
 - (v) a liquid mixture containing 25 g/L betacyfluthrin applied at 16 mL/10 L water by drenching of the growing medium applied 48–72 hours prior to consigning; or
 - (vi) a 100 g/kg chlorpyrifos granular insecticide at 1 kg per cubic metre of growing media, and plants consigned within 12 months; or
 - (vii) a 2 g/kg bifenthrin granular insecticide thoroughly blended at 10 ppm, and plants consigned within 6 months; or
 - (viii) a 2 g/kg bifenthrin granular insecticide thoroughly blended at 12 ppm, and plants consigned within 12 months; or

- (ix) a 2 g/kg bifenthrin granular insecticide thoroughly blended at 15 ppm, and plants consigned within 24 months; or
- (2) in the case of earth and landscaping materials –
 - (a) be treated by –
 - (i) heating the entire mass to a minimum temperature of 65.5°C using steam or dry heat; or
 - (ii) fumigating with a product containing 1000 g/kg methyl bromide, at the rate of 48 g/m³ at 21°C for at least 24 hours; or
 - (iii) in the case of diagnostic samples, freezing to at least -20°C for at least 24 hours; and
 - (b) be produced, stored, handled and consigned in such a manner that would prevent infestation or destroy all life stages of fire ants; and
 - (c) remain packed in the original sealed bag or container in which it was first commercially packed; or
- (3) in the case of hay and straw, be –
 - (a) treated by –
 - (i) fumigation with a product containing 1000 g/kg methyl bromide at a rate of 48 g/m³ at 21°C for at least 24 hours, and
 - (ii) stored, handled and consigned after treatment so as to prevent infestation with fire ants, and
 - (iii) inspected and found to be dry and free of earth material and fire ants, and
 - (iv) dispatched within 28 days of treatment; or
 - (b) processed by hammer milling where –
 - (i) the property has been inspected not less than seven days prior to consignment and found free of fire ants, and
 - (ii) the material is –
 - (A) passed through a mesh of not more than 50 mm in size; and
 - (B) passed over a mesh of not more than 3 mm in size to remove small particulates; and
 - (C) immediately bagged into vacuum sealed bags; and
 - (D) inspected at the rate of 1 in 50 bags to ensure they are properly sealed; or
- (4) in the case of turf, be –
 - (a) treated by cover spraying, at least 48 hours before lifting, with a solution containing 500 g/l of chlorpyrifos applied at the rate of 2 L/ha; and
 - (b) despatched within 28 days of treatment;
 - (c) stored, handled and consigned after harvesting so as to prevent infestation with fire ants or
- (5) in the case of agricultural equipment and used packages, be –
 - (a) cleaned free of earth material and organic matter by –
 - (i) brushing; or
 - (ii) high pressure water; or
 - (iii) steam; and
 - (b) inspected and found free of earth material, organic matter and fire ants.
