## Marine Safety Act 2010

### Section 211(1)(b)

#### NOTICE CONTROLLING NAVIGATION IN THE VICINITY OF WORKS

Parks Victoria, as the declared waterway manager for the waters of the Yarra River upstream of the port waters of the Port of Melbourne, makes the following notice under section 211(1)(b) (i) of the **Marine Safety Act 2010** (the Act) for the purposes of the works activity proposed by SRG Global Pty Ltd to undertake surface remediation to Hoddle Street Bridge.

The navigation and movement of vessels is prohibited from waters of the Yarra River as detailed below in Table 1, excluding vessels involved in the works and Parks Victoria vessels.

**Table 1: Hoddle Street Bridge**

<b>Stage 2:</b> 01 March 2022 to 17 March 2022	Centre span closed to river traffic, extending 20 metres upstream and downstream of the bridge	Navigable spans 2 and 4
<b>Stage 3:</b> 17 March 2022 to 7 April 2022	Southern spans 4 and 5 closed to river traffic, extending 45 metres upstream and 25 metres downstream of the bridge to the southern bank	Navigable spans 2 and 3
<b>Stage 4:</b> 08 April 2022 to 28 April 2022	Southern Span 4 and 5 closed to river traffic, extending 30 metres upstream and downstream of the bridge to the southern bank	Navigable spans 2 and 3
<b>Stage 5:</b> 28 April 2022 to 11 May 2022	Centre span closed to river traffic, extending 20 metres upstream and downstream of the bridge	Navigable spans 2 and 4
<b>Stage 6:</b> 28 April 2022 to 25 May 2022	Northern spans 1 and 2 closed to river traffic, extending 25 metres upstream and 45 metres downstream of the bridge to the northern bank	Navigable spans 3 and 4

The closed bridge spans will be marked by six (6) lit yellow communication buoys and unlit stringline buoys.

Times and dates are subject to change. Changes to times, durations or days will be advertised on Parks Victoria’s website and Notice to River Users.

This notice has effect from 7.00 am on 21 February 2022 to 5.00 pm on 25 May 2022.
