NOTICE OF BOATING ACTIVITY EXCLUSION ZONE

Ports Victoria as the port management authority for the Port of Geelong port waters, hereby gives notice under section 208(2) of the **Marine Safety Act 2010** that all persons and vessels not involved in the Geelong Offshore Superboat Championship 2022 are prohibited from entering and remaining in the waters approximately from Rippleside to Limeburners Point along the southern sector of Corio Bay, bound by the following points marked by buoys:
