NOTICE OF BOATING ACTIVITY EXCLUSION ZONE

Parks Victoria as the declared waterway manager for Yarra River upstream of port waters of the Port of Melbourne, hereby gives notice under section 208(2) of the **Marine Safety Act 2010** that all persons and vessels not registered to take part in the Moomba Festival 2022 are prohibited from entering and remaining in the following waters.
