#### THREATENED SPECIES PROTECTION ACT 1995

I HEREBY GIVE notice in accordance with sections 13(5) and 14(2) of the Act, that I propose to make an Order under Section 13(5) to add Bossiaea heterophylla, Thelymitra inflata and Thelymitra lucida to Schedule 3 Part 1, transfer (omit then add) Veronica notabilis from Schedule 3 Part 2 to Schedule 3 Part 1, transfer Castiarina insculpta from Schedule 3 Part 1 to Schedule 4, transfer Gratiola pubescens from Schedule 4 to Schedule 5, and omit Austrostipa scabra, Scleranthus brockiei and Thismia rodwayi from Schedule 5; and amend the scientific names of Austrocynoglossum latifolium, Brachyglottis brunonis, Blechnum rupestre, Cystoseira trinodis, Leucochrysum albicans var. tricolor, Nematoceras dienemum, Nematoceras sulcatum, Parmelina pallida, Parmelina whinrayi, Viola hederacea subsp. curtisiae, Discocharopa vigens, Helicarion rubicundus, Marginaster littoralis, Miselaoma weldi, Niveoscincus palfreymani, Roblinella agnewi, Tasmaphena lamproides and Thalassarche melanophrys; the common names of 14 taxa and the family names of 71 taxa in Schedules 3, 4 and 5.

### **Personal Information Protection**

### PERSONAL INFORMATION PROTECTION ACT

#### Exemption under section 14

I, Elise Archer, Attorney-General and Minister for Justice, being and as the Minister responsible for the administration of the *Personal Information Protection Act 2004* ("the Act"), upon being satisfied that the public benefit in doing so outweighs to a substantial degree the public benefit from compliance with the personal information protection principles, hereby determine to approve an application dated 27 November 2018 made under section 13 of the Act by the Department of State Growth for an exemption from compliance with the following provisions of the Act with respect to the following information as specified in that application:

- (1) section 17(1) of the Act in so far as it requires compliance with Personal Information Protection Principle 1 (other than with clause 1(2) requiring collection to occur only by lawful means) and Personal Information Protection Principle 2;
- (2) collection by an accredited operator (for the purposes of the *Passenger Transport Services Act 2011*) who is, or becomes, a personal information custodian by reason of the terms of a passenger service contract (for the purposes of that Act) of video footage (including closed circuit television footage) of persons travelling on the regular passenger service (for the purposes of that Act) that is the subject of that contract, and the supply of that footage by the accredited operator to the Department of State Growth;
- (3) collection and use by the Department of State Growth of video footage (including closed circuit television footage) of persons travelling on a regular passenger service that is the subject of passenger service contract (for the purposes of the *Passenger Transport Services Act 2011*).

I have approved the application on condition that the personal information collected by, or collected and supplied by an accredited operator to, the Department of State Growth, is used by the Department for the all or any of the following purposes:

- (a) verifying compliance by an accredited operator (for the purposes of the *Passenger Transport Services Act 2011*) of its obligations under the passenger service contract in respect of that regular passenger service (including in relation to the collection by the accredited operator of passenger fares from passengers who are required to pay fares to use a regular passenger service that is the subject of passenger service contract);
- (b) verifying amounts properly payable by the Crown to an accredited operator under a passenger service contract in respect of a regular passenger service;
- (c) verifying the payment of fares by passengers who are required to pay fares to use a regular passenger service that is the subject of passenger service contract;
- (d) assessing demand for a regular passenger service that is the subject of passenger service contract;
- (e) assessing whether a regular passenger service is being used in conformity with any applicable service eligibility guideline issued under section 51 of the *Passenger Transport Services Act 2011*.

### **Details of the Application**

The Department of State Growth applied under section 13 of the *Personal Information Protection Act 2004* ("the Act") for an exemption under section 14 to allow the collection and disclosure of information, consisting of video footage (including CCTV footage), recorded on a motor vehicle being used to operate a regular passenger service under a passenger service contract (for the purposes of the *Passenger Transport Services Act 2011*), for all or any of the following purposes:

- (a) verifying compliance by an accredited operator (for the purposes of the *Passenger Transport Services Act 2011*) of its obligations under the passenger service contract in respect of that regular passenger service (including in relation to the collection by the accredited operator of passenger fares from passengers who are required to pay fares to use a regular passenger service that is the subject of passenger service contract);
- (b) verifying amounts properly payable by the Crown to an accredited operator under a passenger service contract in respect of a regular passenger service;
- (c) verifying the payment of fares by, passengers who are required to pay fares to use a regular passenger service that is the subject of passenger service contract;
- (d) assessing demand for a regular passenger service that is the subject of passenger service contract;
- (e) assessing whether a regular passenger service is being used in conformity with any applicable service eligibility guideline issued under section 51 of the *Passenger Transport Services Act 2011*.

# Occupational Licensing (Internal Combustion Engine Gas-fitting Work) Exemption Order 2019

I, Dale Edward Webster, Administrator of Occupational Licensing, hereby make this Order under section 99 of the *Occupational Licensing Act 2005*.

# **Order Title**

Occupational Licensing (Internal Combustion Engine Gas-fitting Work) Exemption Order 2019.

# Description

This Order determines the persons (overseas based and specifically trained auto gas-fitters, or their assistants) exempted from holding a licence under the Act for the performance of gas-fitting work on stationary reciprocating engines, in the circumstances, and on the types of equipment, as specified.

# **Revocation**

The Occupational Licensing (Reciprocating Internal Combustion Engine Gas-fitting Work Exemption) Order 2013 is revoked.

# Definitions

"Act" means the Occupational Licensing Act 2005;

**"Automotive gas-fitter practitioner licence"** means the licence specified in clause 8.1 of the Determination;

"Determination" means the Occupational Licensing (Gas-fitting Work Licence Classes – Mobile and Stationary Engine) Determination 2016;

"Gas fuel system" means a gas system that supplies gas as a fuel to an internal combustion engine, regardless of whether or not the gas is supplied concurrently with another fuel;

"Reciprocating internal combustion engine" means a gas-fuelled piston engine in which gas is burned within the engine and for clarification includes piston engines whether stationary or used for the propulsion of a vehicle;

**"Stationary engine gas-fitter practitioner licence"** means the licence specified in clause 8.2 of the Determination.

Occupational Licensing (Reciprocating Internal Combustion Engine Gas-fitting Work Exemption) Order 2019

# **Exemption of specified persons:**

- (1). Overseas-based persons, who have been trained by an original equipment manufacturer or supplier of engines, to service or repair specific types of gas-fuelled internal combustion engines
  - (a) In accordance with section 99(1)(a) of the Act, I exempt the following class of persons from the requirement to hold a licence under provisions of sections 21 and 22(1) of the Act:
    - (i) they have been specially trained by the original engine manufacturer or supplier of gas-fuelled internal combustion engines; and
    - (ii) they are performing prescribed gas fitting work within Tasmania while working on those types of internal combustion engines; and
    - (iii) they are based overseas.
  - (b) This exemption applies only:
    - (i). to the service and repair of the gas fuel systems of internal combustion engines; and
    - (ii). for a period not exceeding five working days on any one occasion while performing prescribed gas-fitting work; and
    - (iii). a person referred to in (1)(a) above is supervised by the holder of:
      - an Automotive Gas-fitter Practitioner Licence; or
      - a Stationary Engine Gas-fitter Practitioner Licence:

with the relevant endorsement, at a level commensurate with their knowledge, skills and experience in accordance with the Occupational Licensing (Supervision of Prescribed Work) Code of Practice 2010, as amended from time to time.

- (c) This exemption does not apply to persons installing or modifying the gas fuel systems of:
  - (i). motor vehicles, forklifts and mobile industrial equipment; or
  - (ii). stationary engines of the types that must be accepted by the Director of Gas Safety in accordance with section 77 of the *Gas Act 2000*.

### (2). Assistants to automotive gas-fitter practitioners

- (a) In accordance with section 99(1)(a) of the Act, I exempt persons from the provisions of section 22(1) of the Act, who are assisting the holders of –
  - (i). an Automotive Gas-fitter Practitioner Licence; or
  - (ii). a Stationary Engine Gas-fitter Practitioner Licence:

while performing prescribed gas-fitting work in association with automotive gas-fitting work or stationary engine gas-fitting work.

(b) The exemption in (2)(a) above, only applies if the person assisting the Automotive Gas-fitter Practitioner or Stationary Engine Gas-fitter Practitioner is supervised at a level commensurate with their knowledge, skills and experience, in accordance with the Occupational Licensing (Supervision of Prescribed Work) Code of Practice 2010, as amended from time to time.
