#### **Notice of Approval of Amendment**

#### **Amendment L173**

The Minister for Planning and Local Government has approved Amendment L173 to the Whittlesea Planning Scheme.

The amendment:

changes the provisions of the Mernda Local Structure Plan which is incorporated into the Local Section of the Whittlesea Planning Scheme under Section 6(2)(j) of the **Planning and Environment Act 1987**. The changes to the Local Structure Plan clarify the timing and method of providing a reticulated sewerage service to the Laurimar Park area which is part of the Mernda Local Structure Plan.
